# Report on the Celebration of the 145th Birth Anniversary of Sripat Singh Dugar

The 145th Birth Anniversary of the founder of Sripat Singh College, Sripat Singh Dugar, was formally observed on 09 January 2025 with due solemnity and institutional dignity. The observance was organised in three phases to ensure ceremonial, social, and academic engagement.

In the first phase, the programme commenced with the offering of floral tributes at the bust of Sripat Singh Dugar, followed by the hoisting of the flag.

In the second phase, a voluntary blood donation camp was organised under the joint initiative of the college's NCC, NSS, and IQAC units, reflecting the institution's commitment to social responsibility. A total of 55 donors, including teachers, non-teaching staff, and students, participated voluntarily in the blood donation drive.

The formal academic session constituted the third phase of the programme and was held at the Rabindra Sabhakaksha. The programme was anchored by Smt. Chaitali Upadhyay and opened with an inaugural song, "Anando Loke," performed by the students. Floral tributes (Malyadan) were offered by Dr. Kamal Krishna Sarkar, Mr. Samir Ghosh, Dr. Priti Kumar Roy Chowdhury, and other members of the faculty. The inaugural address was delivered by Dr. Kamal Krishna Sarkar, Principal of Sripat Singh College, who offered pranam, welcomed the gathering, and reflected on the significance of the day in the institutional calendar.

In his address, the Principal highlighted the steady academic growth of the institution, noting that the college currently caters to more than 5,000 students. He also referred to the successful organisation of the Blood Donation Camp as an extension of the founder's ideals of service and social commitment. He emphasised that education must be guided by ethical responsibility and public service and concluded with the reflection that "Success is not final," encouraging continuous institutional improvement and accountability.

Dr. Priti Kumar Roy Chowdhury was the next speaker and he shared his personal and professional experiences within the institution, expressing his emotional attachment and commitment to academic service. Dr. Sagar Symlandy reflected on the importance of commemorating such occasions to preserve institutional memory and values.

Mr. Samir Ghosh subsequently addressed the gathering, followed by a poetic recitation by Prof. Faruq Abdulla. Dr. Abdul Kader Ahmed discussed the evolution of the education system, outlining its merits and limitations in the contemporary context. A recitation from Rabindranath Tagores' Shankha was presented by Mr. Sudip Bhattacharya. Mr. Dwijen Sarkar critically examined the present education system and cautioned against the commodification of education, while alumnus Mr. Dhruba Nath Roy shared his reflections on the formative role played by the institution in his life.

The programme concluded with the distribution of certificates & prizes to deserving students in recognition of their academic and co-curricular achievements. The formal Vote of Thanks was delivered by Mr. Dibakar Das, Teachers' Counselling Secretary, acknowledging the contributions of all speakers, organisers, teachers, students, and staff. The programme formally ended with the rendition of the National Anthem, marking the successful and meaningful completion of the commemorative observance.






