The webinar had eminent speakers from India and abroad who spoke about the crisis and emphasized for self reliance in rural area through development of smart villages. Key services like Eductaion,health,clean water for drinking and sanitation,ICT connectivity for distance learning,capturing more of agricultural value chain,modern e-health services were all discussed .There were about 80 participants who logged in to listen to the interaction by distinguished resource persons. ### **COVID-19 Pandemic and Self-reliance:**

The COVID-19 pandemic has changed the world in many ways. Of the several implications on humanity, the issues of health, the spiraling down of the economy and social welfare have taken the worst hit. The severe impact of the pandemic is visible across all the sectors of the economy, but its effect on marginalized sections, women and children has been immense in India. Social and economic stress caused by lockdown has multiple impacts. Travel restrictions, loss of livelihoods, limited healthcare facilities and interruption in regular immunizations in hospitals have led to anxiety and fear among the population. Moreover, social distancing with friends and family, the closure of places of entertainment and leisure, closure of educational institutions have all led to increased stress and confusion among the common man. The movement of migrant workers to their hometowns due to uncertainty or loss of livelihoods is one of the cruellest and highlighted issues in this pandemic where millions have been rendered unemployed and stranded without money, food and shelter, crisscrossing the country's highways to return to their villages and several meeting with accidents and deaths on their way. Unemployment has rendered this important segment of our economy in dire states. For all countries bearing the impact of COVID-19 the worst affected is social health and has left the economy gasping. Long-term planning and collective efforts of individuals, communities, governments, national and international organizations to not only fight this invisible deadly virus is needed but also to build up resilience. Policy response to the pandemic to deal with health and the contracted economy is the need of the hour. 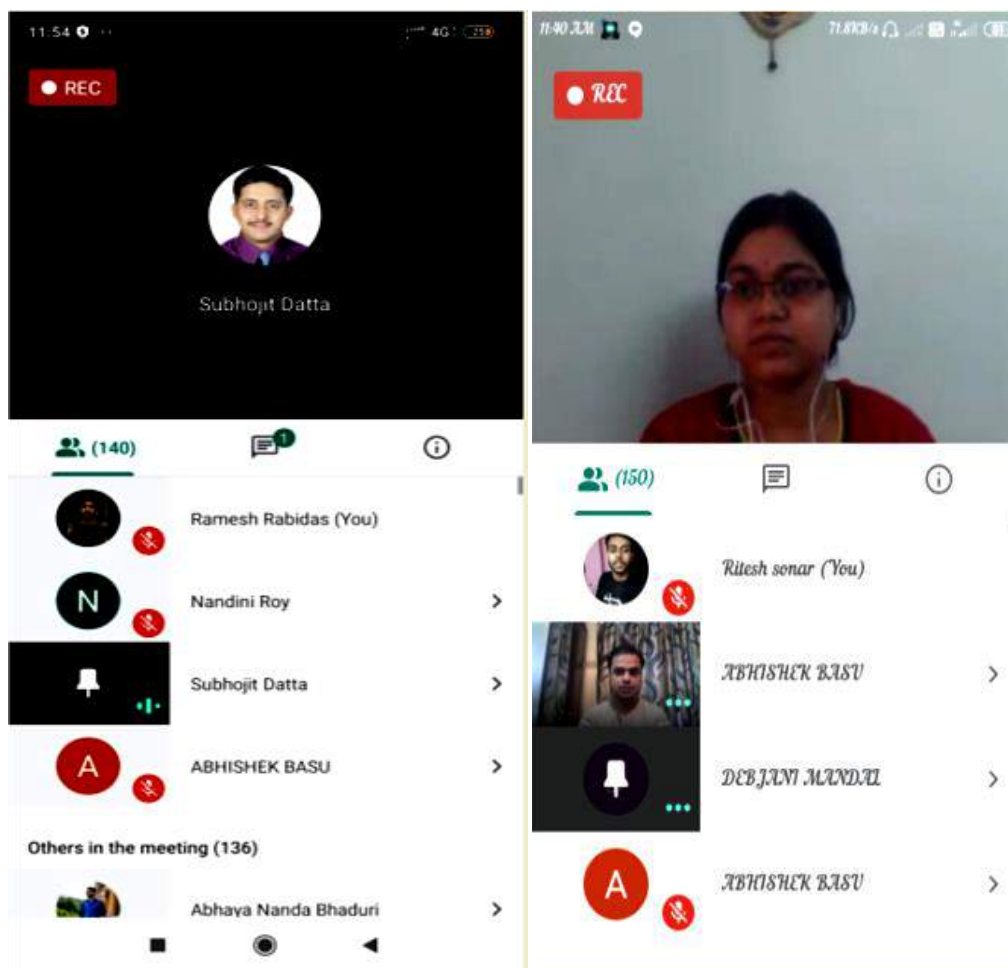

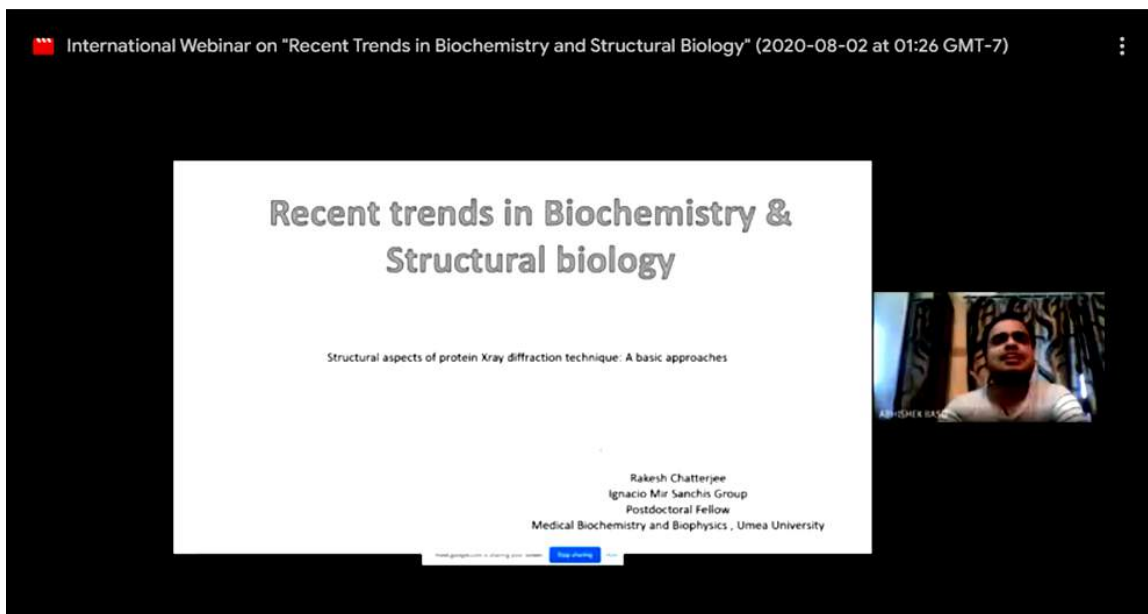

## **About the Sripat Singh College**

Sripat Singh College, established in 1949, is a college in Jiaganj, in Murshidabad district, in the state of West Bengal in India. It offers undergraduate courses in arts and sciences and postgraduate course in Bengali only. It is affiliated to University of Kalyani. Blessed be forever the great name of Sripat Singh Dugar, the magnanimous Sitambar Jain of this town, who made his dream of establishing a college come true on August 1, 1949. In 2018, the complete history from Vedas to Modern Sanskrit up to 2017 by Radhavallava Tripathi has been published in four vols. It narrates Modern Sanskrit literature in a wide landscape. In 2012, 'वागीश्वरीकण्ठसूत्रम्' of Dr. H. Madhav has been published which gives new directions to poetics. Young Poets like Kaushal Tiwari, Narayan Dash, Rushiraj Jani, Praveen Pandya lead Sanskrit to new age. Rushiraj writes short stories in 'चतुरदूरभाषे आषाढः' in which he writes stories on mobile, computer and environment. His 'रक्तशाटीधारिणी माता' applies new techniques of Whatsapp, Flash Back, Juxt a pose etc. Paramananda Jha and Balaram Shukla have written a poetry collection 'लघुसन्देशम्' by SMS, 'तव जवाधरमन्मयरेखासु' of Aruna Ranjana Mishra gives poems of Post Modernism. Dr. Rushiraj Jani translates Dalit Kavya and Adivasi Kavita named 'सूर्यगेहे तमिस्रा' and 'धनुरातनोमि'. Thus the streams of modern Indian poetry enter in to Sanskrit. During the period, 'प्रचेतस्महाकाव्यम्' by Tripathi or original works of Hari Dutt Sharma have been created though both are unpublished. 'द्राक्षावली', 'कल्पवल्ली' and 'गीतगङ्गागोमुखम्' are three anthologies published by Sahitya Akademi, which show richness of Sanskrit. Hundreds of poems are created on 'Carona'. It seems new sensibility of Sanskrit. During March, 2020 to July, 2020, the present writer wrote new Haikus on Face Book which were translated in 13 languages on the same day. They are translated in to Latin by Prof. Marcello Melli of Paroda, Italy. It shows the international fame of Modern Sanskrit Literature.



## POST-MODERNISM IN CONTEMPORARY SANSKRIT LITERATURE

Post-modernism in the world literature was conspicuous in the last decade of the 20th century. Just as modernism in literature appeared after the 16th century industrialization, post-modernism arrived on the boat of globalization - although the post-World War-2 situations are its real breeders.

The post-modernist writings are influenced by the ideas of a post - society. They support mass art as against the class art. Post- modernists reject meta-narratives, but use their fragments for nourishing their writings. Utilization of very untraditional metaphors, fancies and images happens to be the most ostensible feature of such writings. 'Difference' or postponement of meaning is another well-known feature of it too.

When post-modernity relates to a state of society, post-modernism refers to a particular sensibility in literature which appeared in post-modernity that arrived with doubts on the Enlightenment discourse of modernity and with the rejection of the centrality of power or talent. Feminism is another symptom of both post-modernity and post-modernism.

In the contemporary Sanskrit literature, post-modernism became clear in the writings of Dr. Harshdev Madhav, Prof. Keshab Chandra Dash and Prof. Arun Ranjan Mishra - although we find its roots in some poems of Prof. R. V. Tripathi and in some dramas of Prof. Rajendra Mishra. However, a detailed discussion on it is yet to start in the arena of Sanskrit scholars.

## RECENT TRENDS IN CONTEMPORARY SANSKRIT LITERATURE:

### A BIRD'S EYE VIEW

Later half of Twentieth century has witnessed a large volume of original Sanskrit writings not only in India but also in abroad that was never found by any of the preceding centuries. There is an astonishing upsurge of creativity in Sanskrit of last two hundred years. Modern Sanskrit Writings are not only quantitatively but also very qualitatively of such high order that can be treated at par with the best of classical Sanskrit works of any past century. The enormous quantity of published and unpublished Sanskrit works composed during last two centuries encompasses all forms of literature and variety of genres. The Sanskrit Authors displayed an awareness of a changing of socio-political, cultural, economical scenario.

Entirely new themes, idioms, images, metaphors, fantasies, symbols and new models have been evolved in lyrical and epic compositions that have been brought out after the independence. Modern Sanskrit Poets beautifully projected the traditional and modern approaches and attitudes towards metrical expression and lyricism. Now, the concepts of Hero and heroine also have changed in Modern and Post Modern Sanskrit Literature. Now, the Sanskrit poets portrayed the national figures as a hero or heroine with a socio-economic-political background.

We have found some structural changes in different patterns of Sanskrit literature. Various forms of short stories developed in this time. Modern Sanskrit Dramatists now tried to imbibe the concept of 3<sup>rd</sup> Theatre or absurd theatre in their works as experiment. Twenty and twenty first century became the era of translation in Sanskrit arena. Typographical changes are one of the recent trends of Sanskrit Literature. According to me, Our modern or post modern Sanskrit authors are very much effected by the influence of Foreign and regional literatures.

The twenty fast century marks the beginning of post modernism in Sanskrit literature. In the contemporary Sanskrit literature, post-modernism became clear in the writings of Prof. R. Tripathi, Prof. Rajendra Mishra, Dr. Harshdev Madhav, Keshab Chandra Dash and Arun Ranjan Mishra. Love is a very powerful theme in the post-modern literature. So, in contemporary Sanskrit writings, the writers have introduced love as a prominent color. Feminist attitude is also one of interesting feature in post modern Sanskrit writings. Some post-modern Sanskrit poets write free verse poems but at the end of the poem, we easily find out the rhythmic effect and spontaneous overflow of poetic beauty. Usage of foreign meters like Haiku, Tanka, Sijo, Sonet etc. is one of the important feature of Contemporary Sanskrit Literature.

“A second type of new literature written by the traditional Pandit in the British period is panegyric poems on the British Empire, the Crown and the Coronation Durbar. Loyalty to the ruler and the tendency to eulogize him are in the blood of the old style Sanskrit scholars, and only a change of the subject of eulogy from their former local kings to the new Emperor from the far-off land was necessary. The British administrators themselves thought that it would add to their glory to have eulogies in the time-honoured language, and they prompted the writing of these compositions.”<sup>2</sup>

## NEO-SIMILE IN THE POETRY OF A.R. MISHRA

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A.R. Mishra who is teaching Sanskrit in Santiniketan has three collection of post-modern Sanskrit poem books. By now there *TabaJabadharakusumamanmayarekhasu*, *NetrapranteNispandasamaya* and *SunyeMeghaganam*. In the present paper, we want to show the freshness of the simile in different context. The poet has been appreciated by Sanskrit scholar because of his new poetic sensibility, new techniques, new images, metaphor fancies and similes etc in Sanskrit. Simile is the ancient most ornament in Sanskrit literature because it has been used even by the Vedic sphere. *Upama* is widely known as the similarity between two things in a sentence without the expression of dissimilarities — *Samyamvacyambaidharmyamvakyaikeupamadvayah* (*Sahityadarpana*, BiswanathKaviraj). So present poet has used very untraditional similes in his books. Thus the poet ends at the arrival of neo-simile in Sanskrit poetry through the pen of A.R.Mishra.

## POST-COLONIAL THOUGHT:A STUDY FROM MODERN SANSKRIT SHORT STORIES

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The origin and development of modern Sanskrit stories basically divided in three stages – 1. The stories from 19<sup>th</sup> century to later period of this century, 2. The stories before independence and 3. The stories of after independence. Here we see a clear difference from traditional writings. There are contemporary contents, new styles, new concepts, analytical discussions etc. in these. Here also we see reflection of the concept of post – colonial thought. Post- colonial thought is the new discussion element of this and upcoming centuries. Post - colonialism does not mean here after colonial ages and thinking wordy, it indicates new thoughts from traditional activities, believes etc. I will discuss here briefly mentioning some elements from modern Sanskrit short stories. In this discussion I will say how some stories of modern Sanskrit literature reflect the concept by their characters. SitanathAcharjya's*BandhabiRaksita*, Poet TarapadaBhattacharjya's*Maitreyi*, Poet Narayanan Das's*ImranaVadamyaham*, *SafalaNari*, Poet Rakesh Das's*Eka Tamisra* are mentionable stories of this discussion.

## MUSLIM EPIC RAJAVINODA - A GLIMPSE

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Communal fraternity may be two types, Sentimental and Intellectual. The first one implies religious fusion and the rest is reciprocal love for the languages, literatures and cultures of each other. Both of them are interrelated aspects of communal harmony became manifest during Islamic reign in India. Power of assimilation is the characteristic feature of Indian people. The consequence in the medieval ages has, therefore been the fusion Muslim and Hindu culture and civilization. The innermost heart of the Indian people is always alert to receive the truth, whatever be the source and in doing so, it knows no barrier of cast and creed.

*Rajavinoda* is this kind of harmonic production. Great poet *Udayraja* was the writer of this Muslim *Mahakavya* (Epic Poem). This book has seven chapters. This book recounts the entertainments, pastimes and accomplishments of Mamud Begada. The first chapter frames the rest of the work. Saraswati, the Goddess of speech and learning, engages in conversation with Devaraja Indra, and asks why should she return to heaven when such a ruler as MamudBegada rules the Earth? Saraswati retorts that the Sultan has made the Earth a Paradise or the Goddess of Language (Sanskrit).

## ***ALLOPANISAD- A GLIMPE***

*Allopanisad*, Allah Upanisad, the AllaSukta or the Alla Hymn or Mohamad Upanisad these five names are same *Upanisad*. This is a sacred book of untrustworthy origin believed to be written during mohamedan reign in India about 15<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> century. Most probably, it was written in the period of great emperor Akbar. The *Allopanisad* does not appear in the characteristic style of other *Upanisad*. We find the similarity in the style of *Rigveda* Mantras. We do not know what kind of *Upanisad* is this; some scholars may be like the present *Allopanisad* which is supposed to belong to *Atharvaveda*. But we did not found this *Upanisad* in any authentic edition o*Atharvaveda*. Swami Dayananda Saraswati in his Satyarth Prakash elucidated that the *Allopanisad* was not part of the *Upanisad* family and it did not even appear in the *Atharvaveda*. The famous *Muktikacanon*, which was given by Rama to Hanuman as the ilist of authentic 108 Upanisads did not contain Allopanisad. Most scholars viewed that had been written during Akbar' reign. Akbar as a messenger or prophet of God, described the *Allopanisad*. The *Upanisad* has fifteen mantras or verses. It began and ended up with Great Allah.



## **SANSKRIT *PRAŚASTIKĀVYAS* WRITTEN IN SUBJUGATED INDIA: AN EXPLORATORY STUDY**

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Many *Praśastikāvyas* have been written in Sanskrit literature. At different times different Poets have praised their patron kings. India under British rule was no exception. In the Nineteenth century, traditional Sanskrit scholars and modern educated Bengalis wrote *Praśastikāvyas* in Sanskrit for the British rulers. Such *kāvyas* have been written not Only in Bengal but all over India. Those who wrote these *Praśastikāvyas* may have been intimated with the British, or they accepted the British from the heart. The mentality of flattery is clearly reflected in these *kāvyas*. The British rulers liked this trend and encouraged them. Warren Hastings collected such *kāvyas*, presenting them as evidence against his own impeachment. Such *kāvyas* are intended for Queen Victoria (reign from June 21, 1837 to January 22, 1901), Edward VII (reign from 1901 to 1910), George V (reign from 1910 to 1936) and Queen Mary.

### **Research objectives:**

1. To search the Sanskrit *Praśastikāvyas* written during the British rule.
2. To discuss the contribution of Bengal is in the *Praśastikāvyas* written in this period.
3. To review the genres of the *Praśastikāvyas* written during the British rule.

## SELECTED SHORT STORIES OF RABINDRANATH IN INFLUENCE OF CONTEMPORARY SANSKRIT DRAMA

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Since decades, literature of ethnic language is translated in Sanskrit around different provinces of India. Among these some of the works of Bengali literature by Rabindranath Tagore was interpreted and transcribed. Based on the short stories of Tagore, dramas were constructed with different retitling in Sanskrit. Such as – *KhokababurPratyavarttana* was transliterated into *Putra-Pratyavarttanam*, *Postmaster* was converted into *Vartagrhadhyaksa-vaco*, *Rashmanirchele* into *Rasmaniputram*, *Sri-Nalina-parabhavam* arrived from *Phel*, *PutrayajnaasPutrayajnam*, *Guptadhana* expressed as *Guptadhanametc.*

Adaptation of Tagore's short stories and re-titling them into Sanskrit drama was done by Late *Pandit Nityananda Mukhopadhyay*, a renowned person in modern Sanskrit literature as well as writer of more than hundreds of dramas, seven epics (*Mahākāvyas*) etc. These adopted drama had their story line unchanged in addition to conclude in tragedy and pathos. His works also portrayed the confluence of tradition and modernity. He has embraced the the characters of the dramas with compassion. He intruded dramatic excitements and clashes among characters in his creation. Dialogues are short and witty but expressed deep meaning several times.

Nature has played a vital role in Rabindranath's short story. But it is totally invisible in *Nityananda's* drama. *Pandit Mukhopadhyay* tried also to make familiar Sanskrit language among common people. His effort is quite applaudable in this context.

সংস্কৃত পৃথিবীর প্রাচীনভাষা। কিছু কিছু অল্পজ্ঞ লোক একে মৃতভাষা বলে ঘোষণা করেছেন। অনেকে অসংস্কৃতজ্ঞ লোকই বলেন যে সংস্কৃতে ধ্রুপদী সাহিত্য ছাড়া আর কিছুই নেই। কিন্তু সংস্কৃতে ছাত্রী ও শিক্ষিকারূপে জোরের সঙ্গেই বলতে সংস্কৃতভাষা পূর্বের মতই সমৃদ্ধ ও সদা গতিশীল। অনেক গবেষক, শিক্ষার্থী, শিক্ষক, অধ্যাপক এই ভাষাকে প্রতিনিয়ত সমৃদ্ধ করে চলেছেন অদ্যাবধি। শুধু যে রচনাসম্ভার বিপুল তা নয় উৎকৃষ্টতার দিক দিয়েও রচনাগুলির বেশিরভাগই অত্যুত্তম। অনেকেই মনে করেন সংস্কৃতে ঐতিহ্যগত বাধা আছে। যেহেতু এই বিষয়টি শাস্ত্রীয়বিষয়ের মধ্যেই পড়ে, তাই এখানে নতুন চিন্তাভাবনার কোনো স্থান নেই। কিন্তু এই ধারণা সর্বৈব মিথ্যা। এইজন্য একটি বিস্তৃত অধ্যয়ন সমসাময়িক সংস্কৃতসাহিত্যের উপর করা উচিত। তাহলেই এই ধারণা থেকে বেরিয়ে এসে সংস্কৃতির প্রয়োজনীয়তা ও প্রাসঙ্গিকতা অনুধাবন করা যাবে।

সপ্তদশশতাব্দীর পরবর্তীকালেও যে সমভাবে সমানতালে সংস্কৃতগ্রন্থাদি রচিত হয়ে চলেছে তার খোঁজ খুব কম লোকই রাখেন। এর অন্যতম কারণ হল দীর্ঘদিন যাবৎ বিভিন্ন বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ে শুধুমাত্র প্রাচীন সংস্কৃত সাহিত্যই পাঠ্য ছিল। অর্বাচীন রচনার স্থান পাঠ্যক্রমে এসেছে খুব বেশিদিন হয়নি।

এই গবেষণাধর্মী প্রবন্ধে আমরা সংস্কৃতির আধুনিক সাহিত্যের অন্যতম নতুন ধারা গলজ্জলিকা(গজল) কাব্যপদ্ধতির আলোচনা করব প্রফেসর রাজেন্দ্র মিশ্রের আলোকে।

আধুনিক সংস্কৃতসাহিত্য প্রাদেশিক সাহিত্যের দ্বারা প্রভাবিত হয়ে বিভিন্ন নতুন নতুন কাব্যপদ্ধতির প্রভাবে প্রভাবিত হয়েছে। এই রকম কাব্যপদ্ধতির অন্যতম হল গলজ্জলিকা শ্রেণী। আধুনিক সংস্কৃতসাহিত্যের গীতিকবিতাগুলিতে ফার্সীপ্রভাবে গজলের আমদানি ঘটেছে। ভট্টমথুরানাথ শাস্ত্রী সর্বপ্রথম সংস্কৃত গলজ্জলিকা রচনা আরম্ভ করেন। এরপর এই নতুন কাব্যধারায় কাব্যরচনা করে প্রথিত যশা হন জগন্নাথ পাঠক, বচ্চুলাল অবস্থী, রাজেন্দ্র মিশ্র, রাধাবল্লভ ত্রিপাঠী, হর্ষদেব মাধব, পুষ্পাদীক্ষিত প্রমুখ। গলজ্জলিকা ধারাটি জনপ্রিয়তালভের সাথে সাথে এই ধারায় রচনা ও উত্তরোত্তর বৃদ্ধি পেয়েছে। এই খ্যাতির কারণে সহস্রদয়ের মনোগ্রাহীতার জন্য বিভিন্ন আধুনিক কাব্যশাস্ত্রীয় গ্রন্থেও এর স্বরূপ আলোচিত হয়েছে। যেমন- অভিনবকাব্যলংকারসূত্রে এবং অভিরাজযশোভূষণম্ গ্রন্থে। সমস্ত গলজ্জলিকা কবির মধ্যে সর্বাধিক গলজ্জলিকা কাব্যগ্রন্থ লিখে সমাদৃত হয়েছেন প্রফেসর অভিরাজ রাজেন্দ্র মিশ্র। তার রচিত গলজ্জলিকা কাব্যসংকলন গ্রন্থগুলি হল মত্তবারণী(২০০১), কণীনিকা(২০০৮), হবির্ধানী(২০০৯) এবং ঔদুম্বরী(২০১৫)। মূলপ্রবন্ধে তার রচিত গলজ্জলিকাগুলির বিশ্লেষণ এবং এতে আধুনিকতা ও উত্তর আধুনিকতার প্রভাব আলোচনা করব। গলজ্জলিকার স্বরূপ বৈশিষ্ট্য ও এক্ষেত্রে প্রসঙ্গক্রমে আলোচনা করবো এবং সংস্কৃতসাহিত্যে এসে গজলের ক্রমে গলজ্জলিকার রূপ পরিগ্রহণ করেছে। এদের মধ্যে কিছু সাদৃশ্য ও কিছু বৈসাদৃশ্য ইত্যাদি আলোচিত হবে মূল প্রবন্ধে।

## আধুনিক সংস্কৃত নাটকে ব্যবহৃত ভাষা ও শব্দের বিবর্তনঃ একটি সমীক্ষা

নদী চলতে চলতে হঠাৎ করে যেমন বাঁক নেয়, কাব্যও অনুরূপভাবে স্বগতিতে চলতে চলতে হঠাৎ করে বাঁক পরিগ্রহণ করে। কাব্যের এই আকস্মিক পরিবর্তনই আধুনিক কাব্যের সৃষ্টি করে। আধুনিক সংস্কৃতসাহিত্য ভরতমুনি প্রভৃতির নাট্যশাস্ত্রাদি অলংকার গ্রন্থসমূহ পূর্ণতাই যে অনুসরণ করে, তা নয়। আধুনিক সংস্কৃত নাটকে ব্যবহৃত ভাষা ও শব্দে বহুবিধ বিবর্তন পরিলক্ষিত হয়, যা প্রাচীন আলংকারিকগণ কর্তৃক সমর্থিত নয়। বাংলা ভাষায় প্রচলিত প্রবাদবাক্যগুলি আধুনিক সংস্কৃত নাটকে দেবভাষায় ব্যবহৃত হয়। যেমন ‘কারুর পৌষমাস কারুর সর্বনাশ’ প্রবাদ প্রবচনটি ‘জননী’ নাটকে “চারিমাং পৌষমাসঃ মম তু সর্বনাশঃ” ইত্যাকারে প্রযুক্ত হয়েছে। আবার বাংলা, ইংরেজি, উড়িয়া, হিন্দি ইত্যাদি ভাষা থেকে কিছু কিছু শব্দ আধুনিক সংস্কৃত নাটকে ব্যবহৃত হয়। যেমন - কেরোসিন, বস (Bus), গ্যাস (Gas), ট্রাম প্রভৃতি। আধুনিক সংস্কৃত নাটকে ব্যবহৃত ভাষা ও শব্দের বিবর্তন আধুনিক সংস্কৃত সাহিত্যকে এক অন্যমাত্রা প্রদান করেছে।

“It is a tiny verse form in which japanese poets have been working for hundreds of years. Originally it was the first part of the Tanks, a five-line poem often written by two peoples as a literary game”.

‘হাইকু’কেশ্বাসীকাব্যঅর্থাৎএকনিঃশ্বাসেপড়াযাবেএমনকাব্যবলাচলে।ইংরাজীতেযাকে‘One breathepoem’বলাচলে।মূলতঃ১৭টিঅক্ষরেতিনটিচরণেএইকাব্যশৈলী।জাপানীহাইকু‘রপ্রথমওতৃতীয়চরণে৫টিকরেঅক্ষরওদ্বিতীয়চরণে৭টিঅক্ষরপ্রায়শঃদেখাযায়।অর্থাৎহাইকু‘রবিশেষত্বহলএতেশব্দকম, বর্ণনাঅত্যন্তসাবলীলকিন্তুব্যঞ্জনাময়। এইরূপ হাইকুধর্মী কবিতামালা সংস্কৃতসাহিত্যে মূলতঃ আধুনিক সংস্কৃতসাহিত্যে সর্বপ্রথম অবতারণা করেন হর্ষদেব মাধব। প্রায় ২০৩টি হাইকু তিনি প্রণয়ন করেন। গুজরাটী এই কবি একজন সংস্কৃত পণ্ডিত। যিনি প্রায় শতাব্দিক সংস্কৃত গ্রন্থ প্রণয়ন করেন। তাঁর রচিত হাইকুগুলিরমধ্যেঅন্যতমকয়েকটিহল- ‘বেদনা’, ‘ত্বম্’, ‘স্নানগৃহে’, ‘খনিঃ’, ‘মৃত্যুঃ’প্রভৃতি।উদাহরণস্বরূপহর্ষদেবমাধবরচিতএকটিবিখ্যাতহাইকু‘বেদনা’নিম্নেউদ্ধৃতহল-

## ।। আধুনিক সংস্কৃতসাহিত্যে মহাকবি রেবাপ্রসাদ দ্বিবেদী এবং তাঁর 'স্বাতন্ত্রসম্ভবম্' : একটিসমীক্ষা।।

“সাহিত্যশাস্ত্র হল ব্রহ্মবিদ্যা”-এই উক্তির বক্তা **আচার্য রেবাপ্রসাদ দ্বিবেদী** সংস্কৃত সাহিত্যে লক্ষপ্রতিষ্ঠিত মহাকবি, নাট্যকার তথা একজন সমীক্ষক ছিলেন। তিনি জন্মগ্রহণ করেছিলেন ২২শে আগষ্ট ১৯৩৫ খ্রীষ্টাব্দে মধ্যপ্রদেশের সীহোর গ্রামে। তাঁর পিতা ছিলেন পণ্ডিত নর্মদা প্রসাদ। তাঁর মূল নিবাস ছিল এলাহাবাদের ‘কড়া’ নামক স্থানে কিন্তু কালান্তরে তিনি মধ্যপ্রদেশের স্থায়ী নিবাসী হয়েছিলেন। তাঁর পিতা একজন জ্যোতিষাচার্য ও সংস্কৃতের বিদ্বান পণ্ডিত ছিলেন। প্রথাগত শিক্ষা সমাপনের পর তিনি কাশী হিন্দু বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের সংস্কৃত বিভাগের অধ্যক্ষপদ অলংকৃত করেছিলেন। অবসরের পরে ঐ বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়েরই **EMERITUS** প্রফেসর হিসাবে ১৯৯৬ সাল থেকে আজও পর্যন্ত সেই পদ অলংকৃত করে আসছেন। তিনি একজন কাব্যশাস্ত্র মর্মজ্ঞ সহৃদয় কবি।

সংস্কৃত কাব্যশাস্ত্রে তথা নাট্যশাস্ত্রের নবীন সিদ্ধান্তের প্রবর্তক। তিনি তিনটি মহাকাব্য, দশটিরও অধিক কাব্য রচনা করেছিলেন। এছাড়াও, **শেক্সপিয়ার**-এর “**রোমিও জুলিয়েট**”-এর উপর আধারিত বিভিন্ন নাটিকা যুথিকা এবং কয়েকটি কথাকাব্যের ও প্রণয়ন করেন। তন্মধ্যে স্বাতন্ত্রসম্ভবম্ অন্যতম মহাকাব্যরূপে বিশেষ দৃষ্টান্ত লাভ করে। স্বাতন্ত্রসম্ভবম্ আচার্য রেবাপ্রসাদ দ্বিবেদী সনাতনী দ্বারা রচিত এক মহাকাব্য। এই মহাকাব্যের ৭৪টি সর্গে ৬০৬৫টি শ্লোক বিদ্যমান। চুয়াত্তরটি সর্গের মধ্যে প্রথম ২৮টি সর্গের জন্য তাঁর ভারতের বিভিন্ন স্বনামধন্য মাধ্যম থেকে পুরস্কার প্রাপ্তি ঘটেছিল। স্বাতন্ত্রসম্ভব মহাকাব্যে তিনি **স্বাতন্ত্র** পদটির অর্থ শৈবশাস্ত্রের দ্যোতকরূপে চিহ্নিত করেছেন। এই স্বাতন্ত্র শব্দটি ব্যবহার করতে গিয়ে তিনি বলেছেন -“**জীবসেবাই হল শিবসেবা**”। এইজন্যই তিনি এই মহাকাব্যে প্রারম্ভেই শিবপার্বতীকে প্রণাম জ্ঞাপনপূর্বক পরস্পর তিনটি শ্লোকের ব্যবহার করেছেন। সেগুলি হল-

“ওঁ বন্দে পরমেশস্য শিরস্থামৌন্দবীং কলাম্।

আলোচ্য প্রবন্ধে তাঁর একটি আধুনিক বিখ্যাত মহাকাব্য “**স্বাতন্ত্রসম্ভবম্**”-এর সমীক্ষাত্মক মূল্যায়নই হল মুখ্য বিষয়।

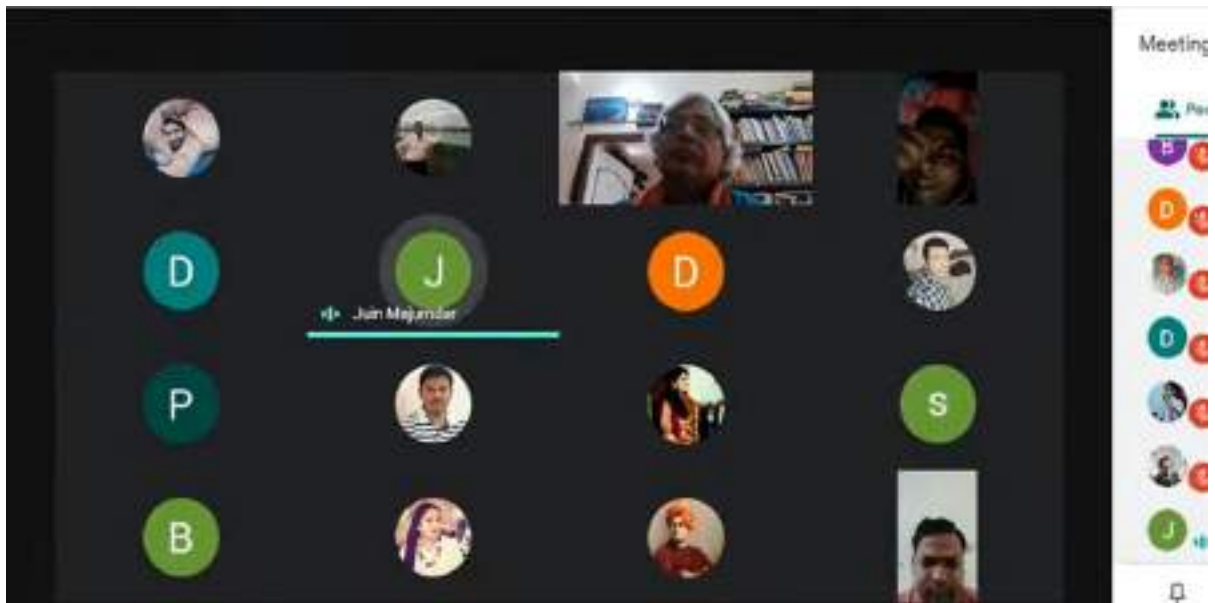

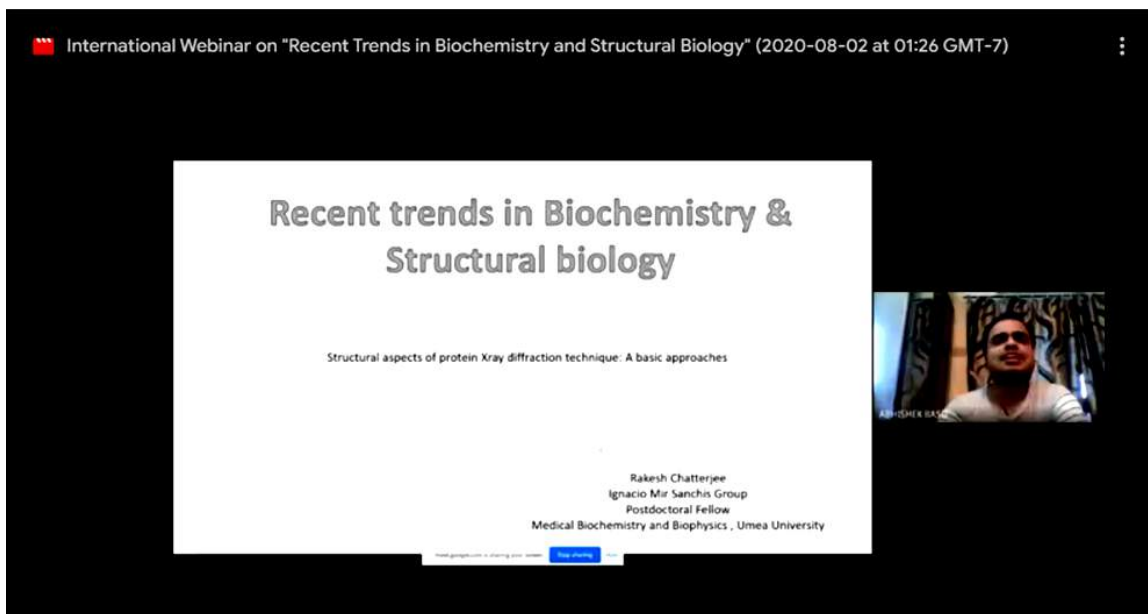
