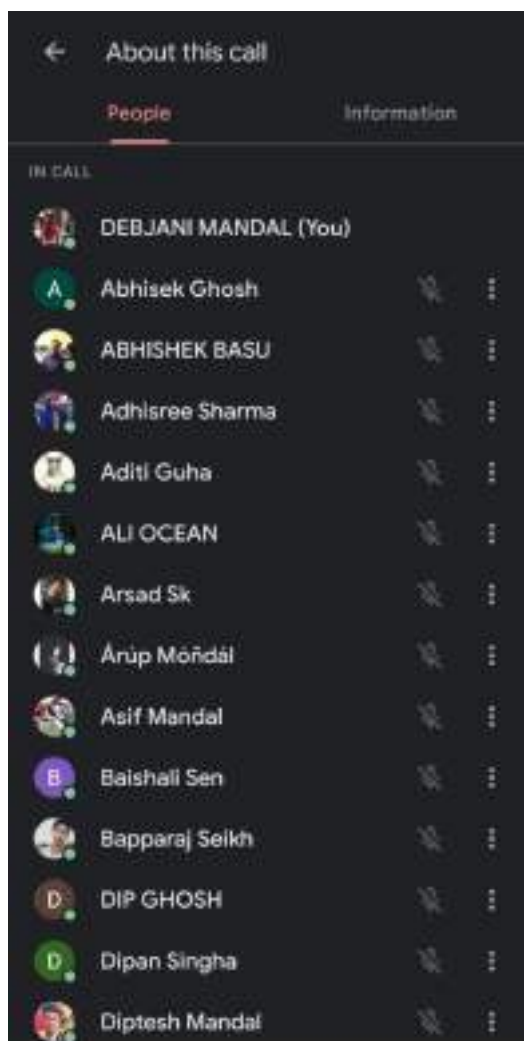
Caption: Brochure of an online Seminar Was On Intellectual Property Rights Awareness

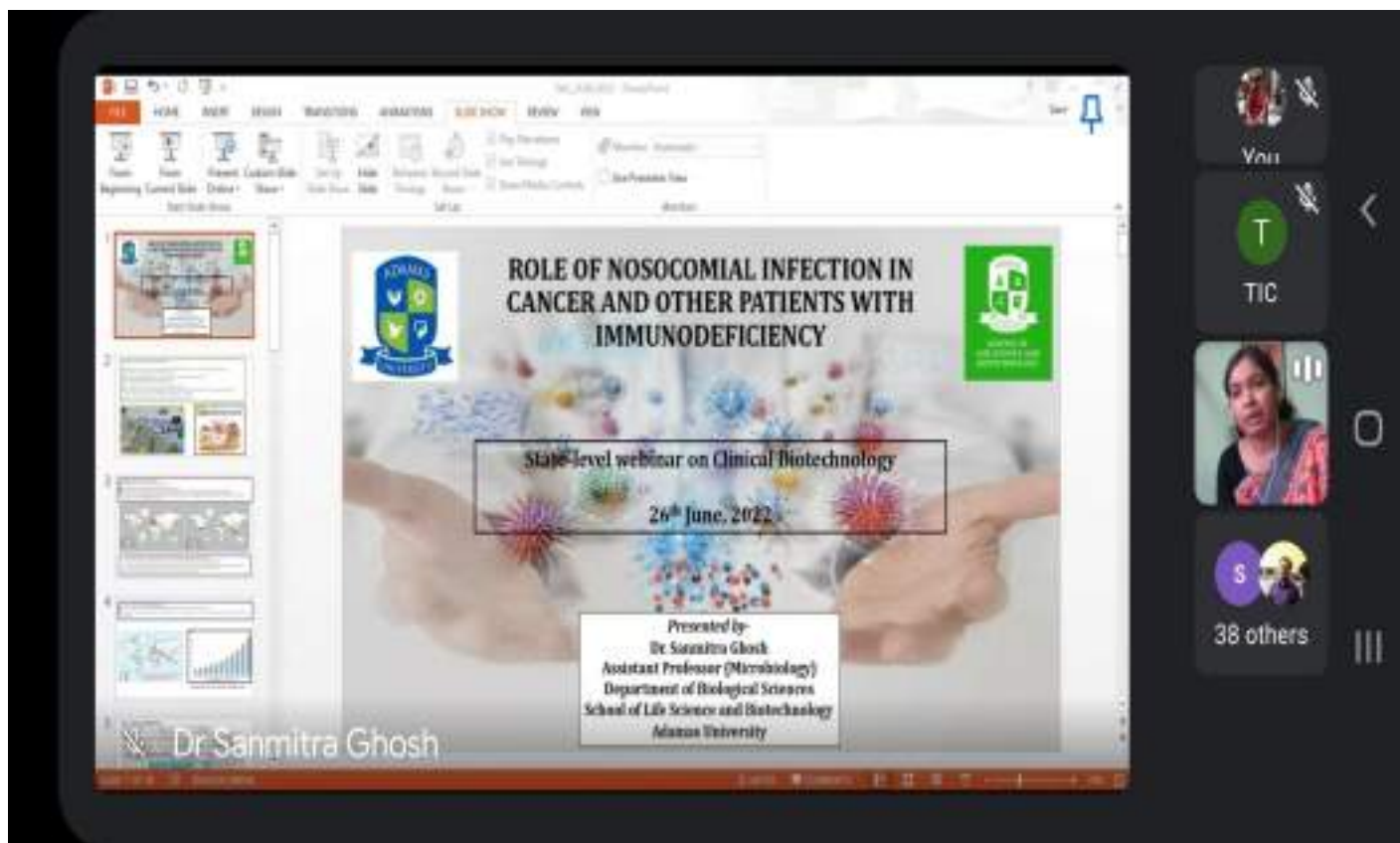

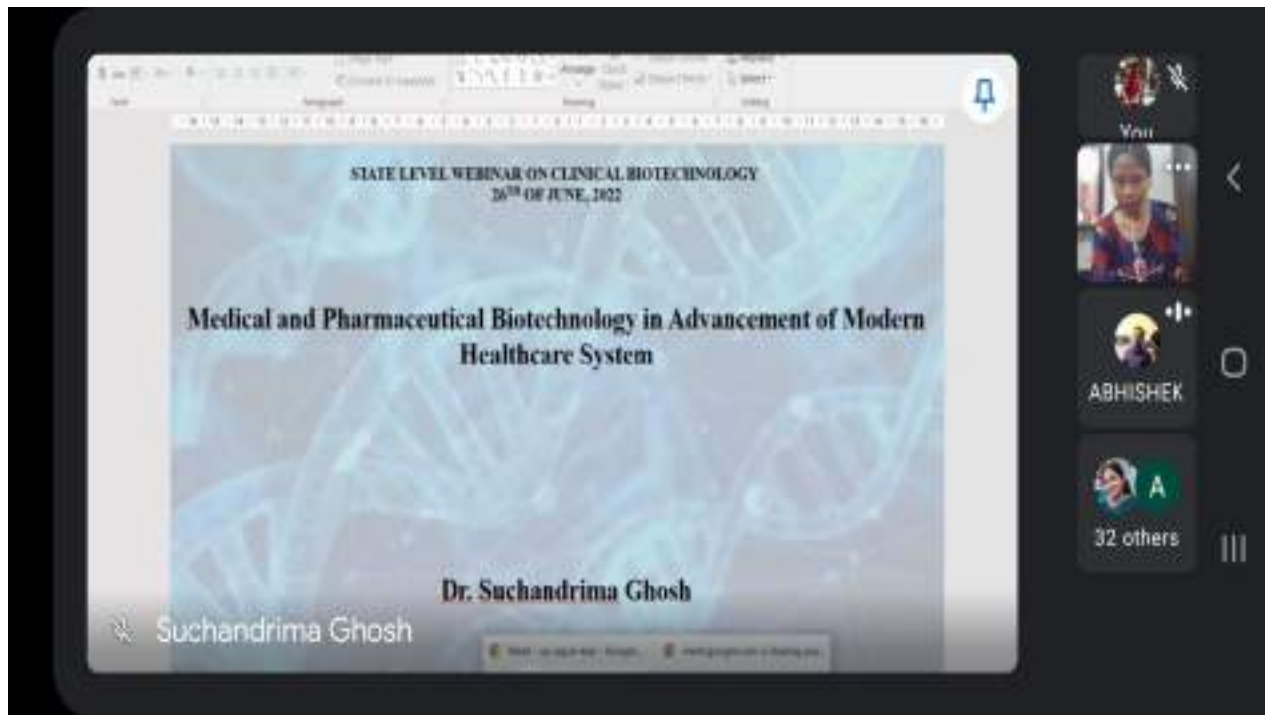

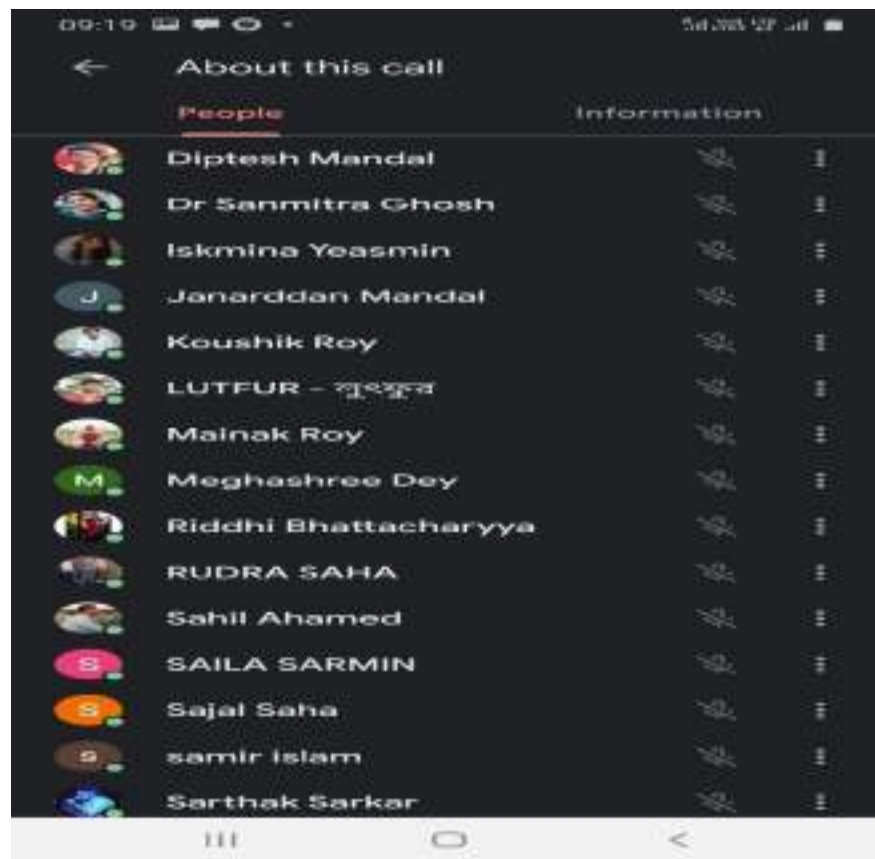
