Report on the Training Programme on Employability Enhancement Skills, in association with Naandi Foundation

A seven-day training programme on Employability Enhancement Skills was organised by Sripat Singh College in collaboration with the Naandi Foundation, commencing on 2 January 2025. The initiative was undertaken with the objective of equipping students with essential competencies required to enhance their employability in a competitive job market. The programme aimed to bridge the gap between academic learning and industry expectations by focusing on practical skill development.

The training module was designed to cover a range of topics, including communication skills, personality development, basic professional etiquette, teamwork, and interview preparedness. Resource persons from the Naandi Foundation were engaged to conduct interactive sessions, workshops, and activities intended to promote active learning and student participation. The programme also sought to instill confidence among students and encourage a proactive approach towards career planning.

Despite the relevance and structured design of the programme, it faced significant challenges in terms of student engagement. From the initial days, attendance of 35 students remained inconsistent, and a noticeable lack of sustained interest among participants affected the overall effectiveness of the sessions. Efforts were made by the organisers to motivate students through announcements, personal outreach, and schedule adjustments; however, these measures did not yield the desired improvement in participation levels.

As the programme progressed, the declining attendance became a matter of concern. The inability to maintain a minimum number of active participants hindered the continuity of interactive and group-based activities, which were central to the training methodology. Consequently, the programme could not achieve its intended outcomes in terms of skill development and student engagement.

In view of the persistent low attendance and limited student interest, the CDCP Cell of the college in consultation with the Naandi Foundation decided to discontinue the programme before its scheduled completion. While the initiative was well-conceived and aligned with the broader goals of enhancing student employability, its premature termination highlights the need for greater awareness, motivation, and alignment of such programmes with student expectations and priorities.

In conclusion, the programme underscores the importance of not only designing skill-based training initiatives but also ensuring adequate student involvement and commitment. Future programmes may benefit from preliminary needs assessments, better scheduling, and enhanced sensitisation efforts to ensure higher participation and successful implementation.

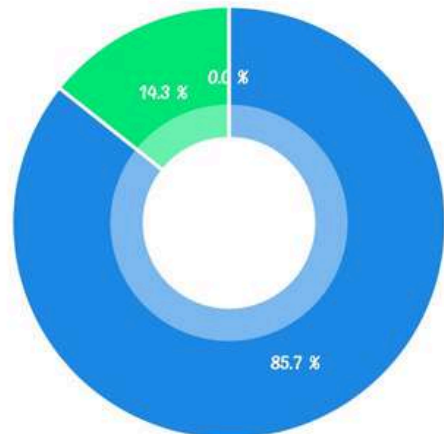
