Online Admission Procedure for Admission to UG Courses 2025-2026 (Under NEP-2020 Curriculum) in Sripat Singh College.

WHO CAN APPLY?

1. A candidate may be admitted to the first semester of four-year(Eight Semester) UG Courses of Studies on passing Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination in General conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or an equivalent examination conducted by other State Board/Council, or The W.B. Council of Rabindra Open Schooling, or The National

Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) recognized by the Distant Education Bureau (DEB) subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned below:

- i <u>Candidates from 'other' Boards</u>: In case of other Boards/Councils, a candidate shall have to pass in five recognized subjects, of which one shall be English, of full marks not being less than 100 each. A candidate passing in less than five subjects shall not be eligible foradmission.
- i <u>Candidates from Vocational Stream:</u> However, Candidates passing Higher Secondary examination from vocational stream conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education & Skill Development (WBSCTVE&SD) or any other equivalent Board/Council are also eligible for admission provided that the candidate must have passed in 5 (five) recognized subjects, of which one shall be English, in the previous qualifying examination.
- 2 Candidates shall be allowed for admission within 03 (three) consecutive academic sessions including the year of passing the previous qualifying examination. (For example: candidates passing **H.S. Examination in the year 2023 will** get last chance of admission in the academic session 2025-2026)

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

4- Year UG Degree (Honours / Honours with Research): A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other Boards / Councils with at least four subjects including English as Compulsory Subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the UG Courses of studies on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subject(s) of the concerned college.

- b. Aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects in order of adding secured by a candidate. Marks obtained in Compulsory Environmental Studies (if any) shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks.
- **c.** A candidate shall be allowed to pursue any one of the Programmes in a particular Academic Session. At the initial stage, every student has to choose one Major subject and two Minor subjects.

Relaxation: There shall be reservation of seats for *Schedule Caste / Schedule Tribe/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ EwS* and Differently-abled Candidates as per Rules/Orders of the State Government.

A candidate shall be allowed to take up the subject(s) under heading '(A)' for taking major/minor subjects if he/she has passed the subject(s) under heading '(B)' at the previous qualifying examination.

Special conditions for admission to a few Major/ Minor Courses

Some special conditions for admission to UG Courses in Chemistry, Economics, Environmental Science, Mathematics, Philosophy, and Molecular Biology & Biotechnology:

- (i) Chemistry: A candidate shall be allowed to take up Major/Minor in Chemistry only if he/she has passed in Chemistry, Physics and Mathematics at the previous qualifying examination.
- (ii) Economics: The subjects Mathematics, Statistics and Business Economics including Business Mathematics be treated as relatedsubjects.
- (iii) Environmental Science: If the candidate does not have EnvironmentalEducation /Environmental Science / Environmental Studies as elective subject then the subjects Biological Sciences, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, Geography, Geology, Mathematics, Modern Computer Application, Physics and Statistics be treated as relatedsubjects.
 - **(iv) Mathematics**: A candidate shall be allowed to take up Major/Minor subject in Mathematics only if he/she has passed in Mathematics at the previous qualifying examination. A candidate who has passed in Business Mathematics is not eligible for admission to Mathematics MajorCourse.
 - (v) Philosophy: The subject Psychology be treated as related subject.
 - (vi) Molecular Biology & Biotechnology: A candidate taking up Major subject in Molecular Biology & Biotechnology must take Chemistry or any one of the following subjects: a) Botany, b) Computer Science, c) Mathematics, d) Physics, e) Physiology, f) Zoology as Minor subjects.

A candidate is required to choose not more than one discipline/ subjects (Minor) from any of the groups mentioned below.
