Report on the International Seminar on Inclusivity, Sustainability, and Gender: Text and Context

An International Seminar on Inclusivity, Sustainability, and Gender: Text and Context was successfully organised by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and the Seminar Committee of Sripat Singh College, Jiaganj, Murshidabad, West Bengal, India, on Wednesday, 28 January 2025, at 11.00 a.m. The seminar was held at Rabindra Sabhakaksha (Room No. 5) of Sripat Singh College in collaboration with Women's College, Calcutta; Nabadwip Vidyasagar College; SRF College, Beldanga; and Berhampore Girls' College, reflecting a strong culture of inter-institutional academic cooperation.

The seminar aimed to promote critical and interdisciplinary engagement with contemporary debates on gender, inclusivity, and sustainability, drawing insights from literature, social sciences, political theory, history, and cultural studies. The event witnessed active participation from academicians, researchers, students, and scholars from various institutions across India and abroad, thereby creating a vibrant platform for intellectual exchange and scholarly dialogue.

The programme was graced by Prof. Jane Alam, Vice-Chancellor, Murshidabad University, as the Chief Guest, while Mrs. Shaoni Singha Roy, President of the Governing Body, Sripat Singh College, served as the Chief Patron. The seminar was patronised by Dr. Kamal Krishna Sarkar, Principal, Sripat Singh College; Dr. Hena Sinha, Principal, Berhampore Girls' College; Dr. Anupama Choudhury, Principal, Women's College, Calcutta; Dr. Swapan Kumar Roy, Principal, Nabadwip Vidyasagar College; and Dr. Suhas Roy, Principal, SRF College, Beldanga. The distinguished resource persons included Dr. Dibyadyuti Sarkar of Noakhali Science and Technology University, Bangladesh, and Prof. Amita Kumari of Sido Kanhu Murmu University.

The inaugural session was anchored by Dr. Abhisekh Basu, who formally welcomed the gathering and outlined the objectives of the seminar. The distinguished guests—Prof. Jane Alam, Dr. Hena Sinha, and Dr. Anupama Choudhury & all dignitaries were felicitated in recognition of their academic contributions & valuable inputs to the society. The session commenced with the ceremonial lighting of the lamp, followed by the inaugural song “Deepojyoti” and a cultural presentation, “Madhuro Dhoni Baje,” by the students, which added a solemn and reflective tone to the proceedings.

In his inaugural address, Dr. Kamal Krishna Sarkar, Principal of Sripat Singh College, warmly welcomed the Chief Guest, resource persons, collaborators, and participants. He emphasised the importance of inclusive education, gender justice, and sustainability in the contemporary academic and social context, and expressed confidence that the seminar would generate meaningful academic outcomes. Dr. Sagar Simlandy, Convenor of the Seminar, subsequently presented an overview of the programme, highlighting the submission of 98 research papers online from scholars of various institutions and expressing gratitude to all collaborators, faculty members, and students for their support.

In his keynote address, Prof. Jane Alam underscored the persistent challenges of women’s empowerment and observed that society still has “miles to go” in achieving genuine gender equality. Drawing upon literary and cultural references from Rabindranath Tagore and Kazi Nazrul Islam, He reflected on representations of women in texts such as Ghare Baire and stressed the need to critically reassess entrenched social norms. He also highlighted the role of education, particularly the New Education Policy, in dismantling structural inequalities and inaugurating new global avenues for inclusive and sustainable development. The Abstract Book of the seminar was formally inaugurated during this session.

The subsequent session, anchored by Ms. Chaitali Upadhyay, featured special addresses by Dr. Hena Sinha and Dr. Anupama Choudhury. Dr. Hena Sinha focused on gender theory, inclusivity, and sustainability through examples from Bengali literature, addressing marginalisation, caste hierarchies, and women's lived experiences, and advocating the need to unlearn and relearn in order to construct new social narratives. Dr. Anupama Choudhury delivered a scholarly lecture titled "Undoing Gender for Empowerment, Inclusivity, and Sustainability," emphasising the dynamic and performative nature of gender, as articulated by Judith Butler, and introducing the concept of Queer Economic Geography through empirical research conducted between 2010 and 2024 across several Indian cities.

The technical sessions included lectures by Dr. Dibyadyuti Sarkar on "Sri Chinmoy: An Apostle of Inclusivity Beyond Borders, Faiths, and Nations" and Prof. Amita Kumari on "Towards an Ecofeminist Understanding of Adivasi Societies," followed by interactive discussions. The seminar further featured offline and online paper presentation sessions, enabling wide scholarly participation. The valedictory session included certificate distribution and participant feedback, and the programme concluded with a vote of thanks by Mr. Dibakar Das, TCS, Sripat Singh College, followed by the National Anthem. Overall, the seminar successfully fulfilled its objectives by fostering interdisciplinary dialogue, enriching academic discourse, and strengthening institutional collaboration on critical contemporary issues.

1. **Enhanced Interdisciplinary Understanding:** The seminar facilitated comprehensive interdisciplinary dialogue on gender, inclusivity, and sustainability by integrating perspectives from political science, history, literature, and socio-cultural studies. Participants developed a broader conceptual understanding of these interconnected themes.
2. **Strengthening of Institutional Collaboration:** The collaborative engagement between Sripat Singh College and partner institutions—including Women's College, Calcutta; Nabadwip Vidyasagar College; SRF College, Beldanga; and Berhampore Girls' College—strengthened academic networking and fostered future possibilities for joint research and exchange programmes.
3. **Promotion of Gender Sensitisation and Inclusivity :** Through keynote addresses and scholarly discussions, the seminar heightened awareness regarding gender equity, marginalisation, queer inclusion, and ecofeminist perspectives. Participants were encouraged to critically reassess social constructs and contribute to inclusive academic and social environments.
4. **Research Enrichment and Scholarly Exposure :** The presentation of 98 research papers (both online and offline) provided a valuable platform for scholars, faculty members, and students to present their work, receive constructive feedback, and refine their research methodologies.
5. **Global and Cross-Border Academic Engagement :** The participation of an international resource person from Bangladesh added a cross-cultural dimension to the discussions, enhancing global academic perspectives and strengthening international academic ties.
6. **Encouragement of Emerging Researcher:** The seminar created opportunities for young researchers and postgraduate students to engage in scholarly discourse, thereby promoting research culture and academic confidence among early-career scholars.
7. **Integration of Policy and Practice :** Discussions relating to the New Education Policy, sustainable development, and socio-economic inclusion highlighted the practical implications of academic research in shaping policy and social transformation.
8. **Publication and Documentation :** The inauguration of the Abstract Book ensured systematic documentation of scholarly contributions, thereby contributing to institutional academic records and future research reference.
9. **Awareness of Sustainable and Inclusive Development Goals :** The seminar reinforced the importance of aligning academic discourse with sustainable development goals, particularly in relation to gender equality, social justice, and ecological responsibility. Institutional Quality Enhancement
