Workshop On Waste Management: (14/04/2024)

Waste management or waste disposal includes the processes and actions required to manage waste from its inception to its final disposal. This includes the collection, transport, treatment, and disposal of waste, together with monitoring and regulation of the waste management process and waste-related laws, technologies, and economic mechanisms. Waste can either be solid, liquid, or gases and each type has different methods of disposal and management.

NSS Unit of Sripat Singh College in Collaboration with IQAC organized a Waste Management Workshop on 19th Apr,2024. On that day, the programme was inaugurated by Dr. Kamal Krishna Sarkar, Principal. Dr. Sagar Simlandy (IQAC Co-Ordinator), Dr. Shibu Paul (NSS Program Officer) and all the teaching staff were present in the program.



Dengue Awareness Programme (14/05/2024)

Dengue is a mosquito-borne viral infection, found in tropical and sub-tropical climates worldwide, and mostly in urban and semi-urban areas. There are four Dengue serotypes and it is possible to be infected four times, each time by a different serotype. Most infectious cause only mild flu-like symptoms but they can also develop into a lethal complication called severe dengue which is a leading cause of serious illness and death in some Asian and Latin American countries. Several methods can be used for diagnosis including RT-qPCR, rapid antigen tests for the NS1 protein, and serological assays that detect both IgG and IgM antibodies to the four dengue

serotypes.

NSS Unit of Sripat Singh College organized a Dengue Awareness programme to make our students aware of the symptoms, causes and diagnosis etc. Dr. Shibu Paul, Programme Officer, delivered lecture on the topic.



Voters Awareness Campaign (22//05/2024)

A lot of people want to vote, but many are not aware of its need and how to cast it. This is where voting awareness comes into play. The idea of voting awareness is to help people understand the importance of voting. Voting is an important way for voters to control their government. It is a method for citizens to express what they want from their leaders by raising awareness about voting. This will lead to better governance and what everyone wants - a democracy that is free, fair and representative.

NSS Unit of Sripat Singh College organized a Voters Awareness program to make the students aware of their right to vote on 22nd of May,2024. International Yog Day Celebration: (21/06/2024)

Yoga is the ancient way to attain physical, mental, and spiritual practice. Primarily originating in India, the word 'yoga' is derived from Sanskrit, meaning to unite. This unity signifies the ultimate union of the body with consciousness and thus attaining definitive peace.

Recognizing the universal appeal of Yoga, on December 11 2014, the United Nations proclaimed June 21 to be marked as the International Day of Yoga.

He celebrated Yoga Day for the first time on June 21 in 2015, after which Yoga Day started being celebrated all over the world on June 15, and it turned into International Yoga Day. Since then, Yoga Day has been celebrated every year by the Ministry of Ayurveda, Yoga, Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha, Sowa-Rigpa and Homoeopathy (AYUSH) in India.

Van Mahotsav: (18/07/2024)

The words "Van" and "Mahotsav" are derived from Sanskrit language. "Van" which can also be spelled as "Vana" refers to "Forest", and "Mahotsav" is a combination of "Maha" meaning great and "Utsav" meaning festival. So the literal meaning of "Van Mahotsav" can be deduced to "A Great Forest-Festival", an event which is celebrated by the Indian community throughout the world with the central theme of planting trees.

NSS Unit of Sripat Singh College also observed the day by planting 100 saplings at our college surroundings.




Health AwarenProgramme (26/07/2024)
