REPORT ON THE OBSERVANCE OF DR. SYAMA PRASAD MUKHERJEE FORTNIGHT AND READING SESSION ON DR. SYAMA PRASAD MUKHERJEE'S WRITINGS AND SPEECHES

The Department of History, Sripat Singh College, organized a Reading Session on Dr. Syama Prasad Mukherjee's Writings and Speeches on 23 June 2026 at 12:00 Noon in Rabindra Sabhakaksha (Room No. 5) as part of the observance of Dr. Syama Prasad Mukherjee Fortnight (23 June - 6 July, 2026). The programme was conducted with the objective of familiarizing students with the life, ideals, intellectual contributions, and patriotic vision of Dr. Syama Prasad Mukherjee. The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from students and faculty members and served as an important academic platform for reflection, discussion, and knowledge-sharing.

The programme commenced with the ceremonial lighting of the lamp, followed by a rendition of Vande Mataram by the students. The session was smoothly anchored by Dr. Somenath Bhattacharya. A floral tribute was offered to the portrait of Dr. Syama Prasad Mukherjee as a mark of respect and remembrance. The inaugural session was addressed by Dr. Kamal Krishna Sarkar, Principal of Sripat Singh College, who highlighted the historical significance of Dr. Mukherjee's contributions to education, nation-building, and public life. In his welcome address, he emphasized the importance of studying the life and ideals of great national leaders and encouraged students to engage critically with historical writings and speeches.

Following the lectures, the Reading Session formally began, during which students presented and discussed selected writings and speeches of Dr. Mukherjee. A total of 27 student groups actively participated in the reading and discussion sessions, demonstrating keen interest and thoughtful engagement with the texts.


The programme recorded an attendance of more than 120 students, reflecting the overwhelming response and academic enthusiasm of the student community. The reading session encouraged critical thinking, historical awareness, and meaningful dialogue among participants.
