REPORT ON THE PLAQUE UNVEILING CEREMONY OF PRATICHI BOYS' AND GIRLS' HOSTELS, ALUMNI REUNION CUM MEET, AND GRAND LAUNCH OF THE BOOK ON INDIAN KNOWLEDGE SYSTEM AT SRIPAT SINGH COLLEGE

Sripat Singh College organized a memorable and multifaceted academic and institutional event on 15 May 2026 at 12:00 noon, encompassing the Plaque Unveiling Ceremony of the Pratichi Boys' Hostel and Girls' Hostel, the Alumni Reunion cum Meet, and the Grand Launch of a book on the Indian Knowledge System. 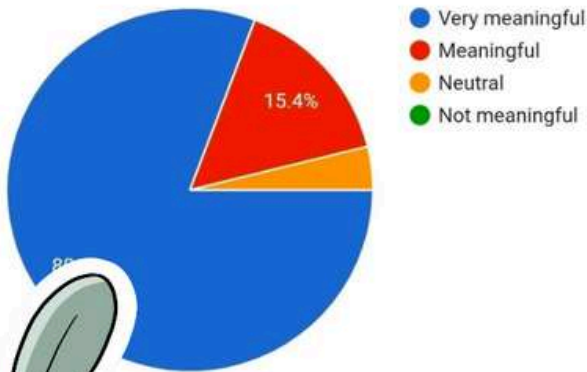

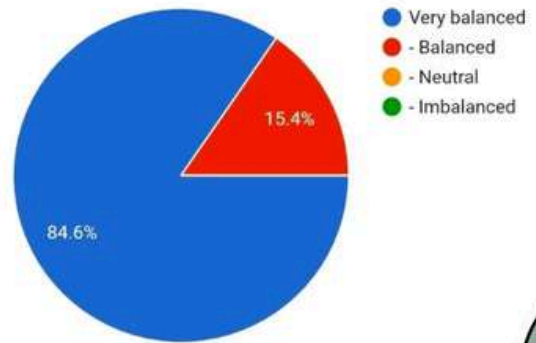

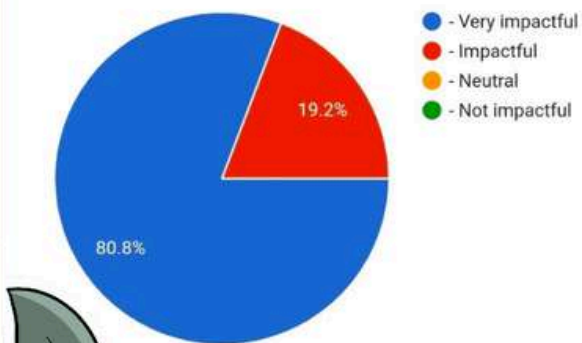

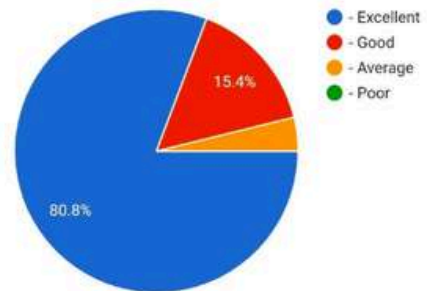
