Background

As part of the observance of **Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee Fortnight-2026**, Sripat Singh College organized a **State-Level Seminar** entitled "**Revisiting the Thought and Legacy of Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee.**" The programme was organized by the Seminar Committee in collaboration with IQAC with the objective of promoting awareness of the life, philosophy, educational vision, and nation-building contributions of

Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee among students, teachers, researchers, and the academic community. The programme was conducted in accordance with the resolution adopted in the Seminar Committee meeting held prior to the event.

Objectives

- To commemorate the life and contributions of Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee.
- To familiarize students with his educational philosophy and vision for nation-building.
- To encourage critical discussion on his political thought and historical contributions.
- To promote interdisciplinary academic dialogue among faculty members and students.
- To inculcate constitutional values, patriotism, and responsible citizenship.

Programme Highlights

The programme commenced with the **welcome address** by **Dr. Kamal Krishna Sarkar**, Principal of Sripat Singh College.

The inaugural session included

- Lighting of the ceremonial lamp
- Floral tribute to the portrait of Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee
- Rendering of **Vande Mataram**
- Welcome address by the Principal
- Brief address by the Secretary of the Teachers' Council

The invited speakers included:

- **Dr. Ranabir Nath**, Associate Professor, Department of Bengali, Sripat Singh College

The programme concluded with the **Vote of Thanks** by **Dr. Emili Rumi** followed by the **National Anthem**.

The programme was jointly anchored by **Dr. Abhishek Basu** and **Mr. Tanmoy Malakar**.

Summary of Academic Deliberations

Prof. (Dr.) Debashis Chatterjee

The keynote speaker discussed Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee's educational philosophy, scientific outlook, and vision of a self-reliant India. He emphasized value-based education, skill-oriented learning, and the continued relevance of Dr. Mookerjee's educational policies in contemporary India.

Dr. Ranabir Nath

He highlighted Dr. Mookerjee's pivotal role in safeguarding the territorial identity of West Bengal and elaborated on his contribution to Indian nationalism, education, and public life.

Dr. Sagar Simlandy

Through historical analysis, he examined the political developments of pre-independence India and discussed Dr. Mookerjee's role alongside the Muslim League, the Indian National Congress, and Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose. His lecture presented Dr. Mookerjee as a visionary leader, institution builder, and nationalist thinker.

The seminar witnessed active participation from

The attendance records indicate participation of both faculty members and a large number of students from multiple academic departments.

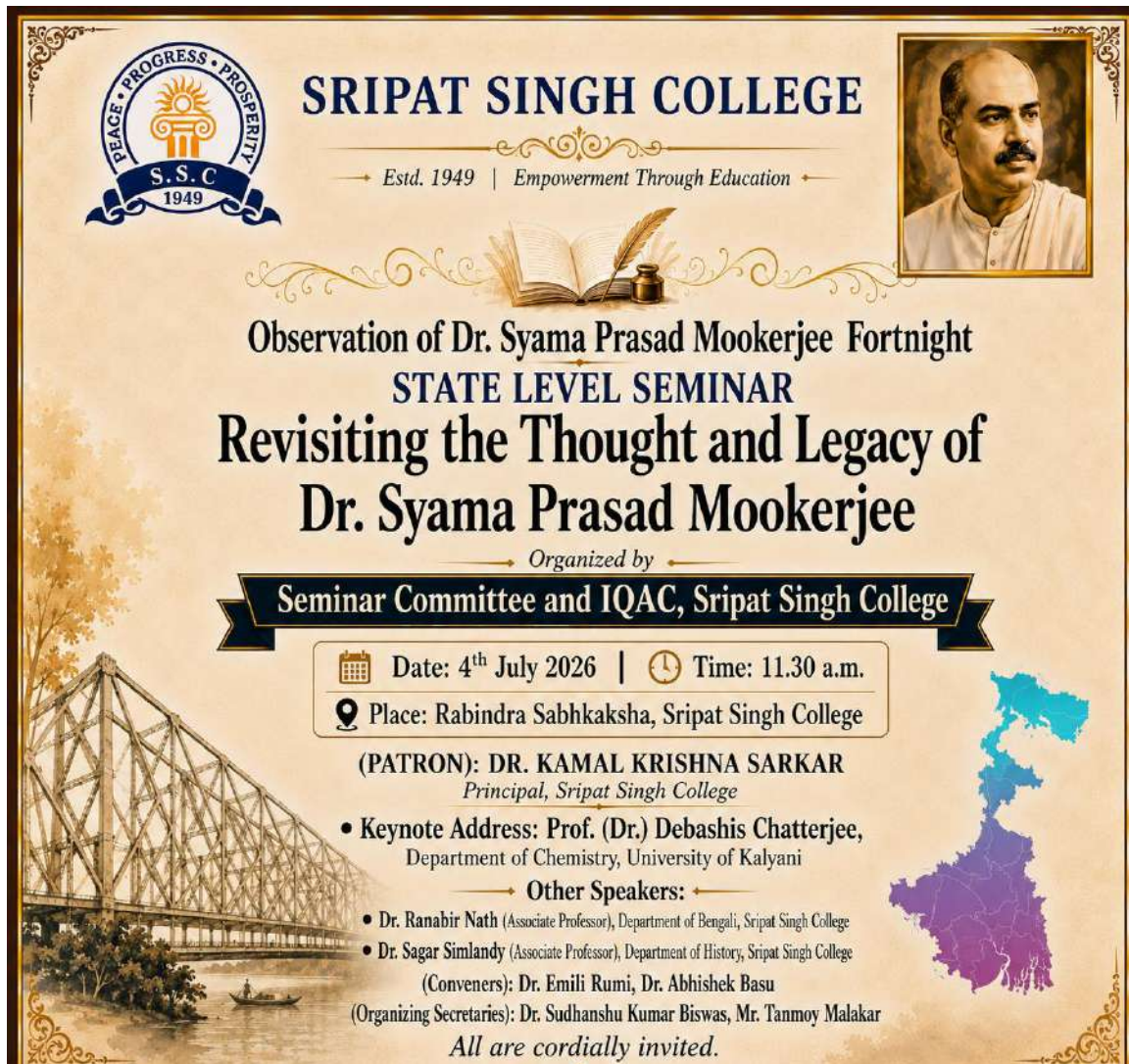
Conclusion

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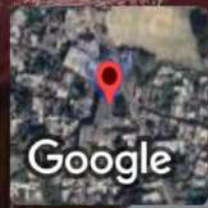
