Report on Faculty Interaction Session

On 13th December 2024, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Sripat Singh College organized an engaging Faculty Interaction Session on the theme, “Student Success as an Organizing Principle for Undergraduate Education: Implications for Faculty,” at Rabindra Sabhakaksha. Held at 1:15 PM, the event provided a platform for educators to explore innovative strategies for enhancing undergraduate student success. Anchored by Dr. Himadri Guhathakurta, the session began with a warm welcome to attendees and an introduction to the objectives of the interaction. Dr. Kamal Krishna Sarkar, Principal of Sripat Singh College, inaugurated the program, highlighting the evolving role of faculty in shaping a student-centric learning environment. Dr. Sagar Simlandy, IQAC Coordinator, elaborated on the session's theme, emphasizing its importance in addressing contemporary challenges in higher education.

The keynote address was delivered by Dr. Rajib Doogar, Area Coordinator of Accounting and Professor at the University of Washington. In his insightful address, Dr. Doogar referred to this interaction as “adda,” a Bengali term signifying an informal yet meaningful conversation. This approach created a relaxed and engaging atmosphere, encouraging open dialogue. Dr. Doogar focused on the need to prioritize student success as a guiding principle in undergraduate education. He advocated for fostering open communication between faculty and students to build trust and create a supportive learning atmosphere. Dr. Doogar emphasized the significance of implementing an effective mentor-mentee system, which could provide personalized guidance to students and help them navigate academic and personal challenges more effectively. He also addressed the critical issue of student dropouts, sharing strategies for early identification of at-risk students and offering tailored interventions to help them stay engaged. His emphasis on creating an inclusive environment to re-engage students resonated strongly with the audience. A highlight of the event was Dr. Himadri Guhathakurta’s proposal for a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the University of Washington, aimed at common ground.

The interactive Q&A session was a highlight of the event, allowing faculty members to engage directly with Dr. Doogar. They shared their concerns and sought solutions for implementing student-first teaching practices. Dr. Doogar's practical and experience-driven responses inspired educators to adopt innovative strategies and proactive measures to improve student outcomes. The session concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Dr. Sagar Simlandy, who expressed gratitude to Dr. Rajib Doogar for his transformative address and to Dr. Guhathakurta for his leadership in organizing the event. This impactful session marked a significant step forward in fostering a collaborative, inclusive, and student-focused academic ecosystem at Sripat Singh College. It underscored the importance of equipping educators with tools and strategies to create meaningful learning experiences, paving the way for sustained student success.
