## Report on International Women's Day Celebration at Sripat Singh College

Sripat Singh College commemorated International Women's Day with due dignity and solemnity, reflecting its commitment to gender equity and social awareness. The event was jointly organised by the Internal Complaints Committee, the Women's Cell and the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) on 18 March 2026, at 11:30 A.M. thereby ensuring a collaborative and inclusive approach. The programme commenced with the ceremonial lighting of the lamp, symbolising knowledge and enlightenment, followed by a collective recitation of mantras that created a solemn and spiritual ambience. The inaugural song was performed by the students of the college's cultural group, adding a melodious and captivating dimension to the proceedings and setting a tone of inspiration and reverence for the day's activities.

The Principal of the College, Dr Kamal Krishna Sarkar, delivered the keynote address, emphasising the importance of women's empowerment and the role of educational institutions in fostering equality. 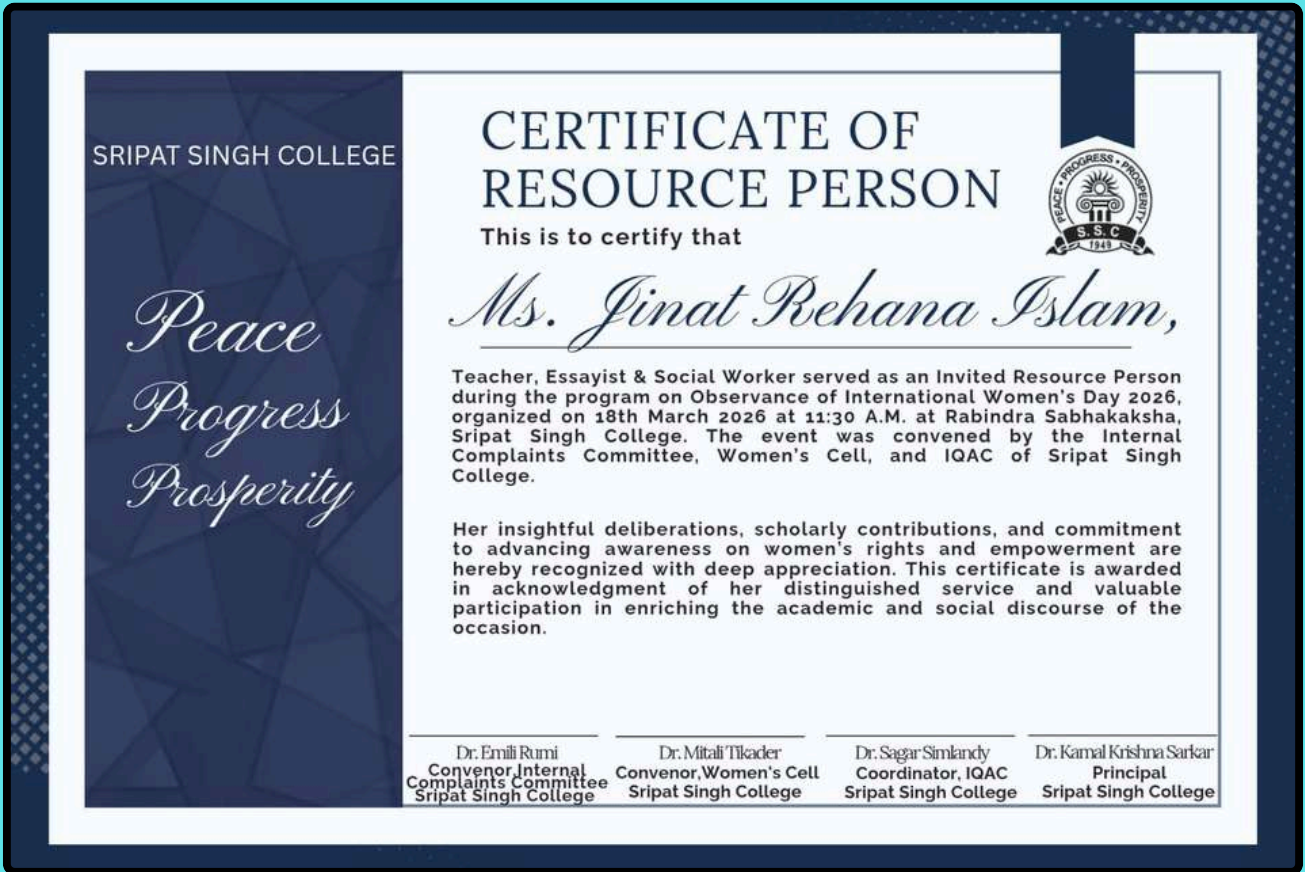
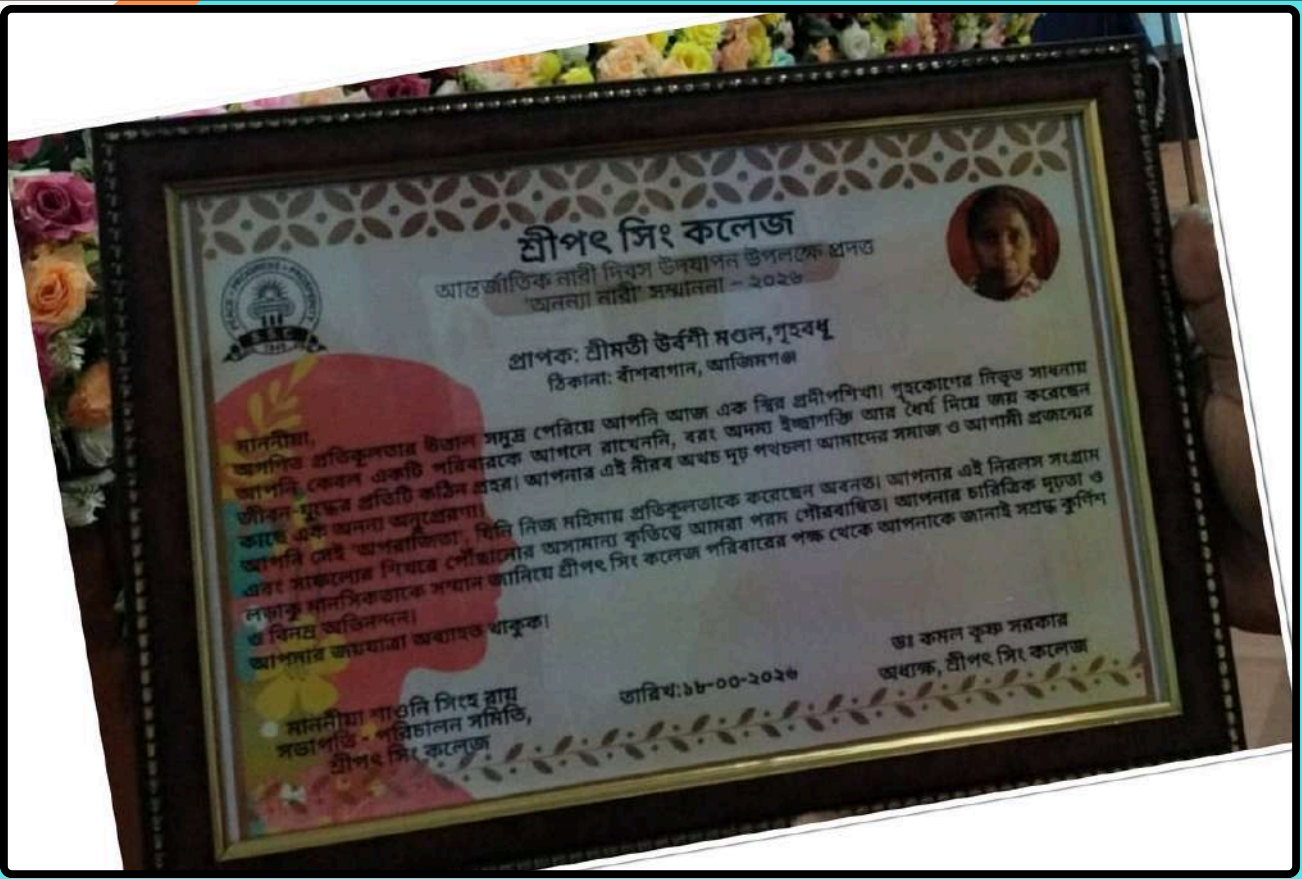
