## **Report on the Faculty–Student Exchange Programme under MoU Activities**

**The Department of History, in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Sripat Singh College, organized a Faculty–Student Exchange Programme under MoU activities on 16th August, 2025. The programme was conceptualized with the objective of fostering academic collaboration, strengthening institutional ties, and enriching the teaching–learning process beyond conventional classroom boundaries.**

**The programme was attended by faculty members and students of both Sripat Singh College and Jangipur College. The distinguished presence of Dr. Kamal Krishna Sarkar, Principal of Sripat Singh College and Dr. Prarthita Biswas, Principal of Jangipur College, added significance to the event. The Heads of the Departments of History from both institutions, along with their faculty colleagues, also attended the programme, thereby ensuring strong academic representation from both sides.**

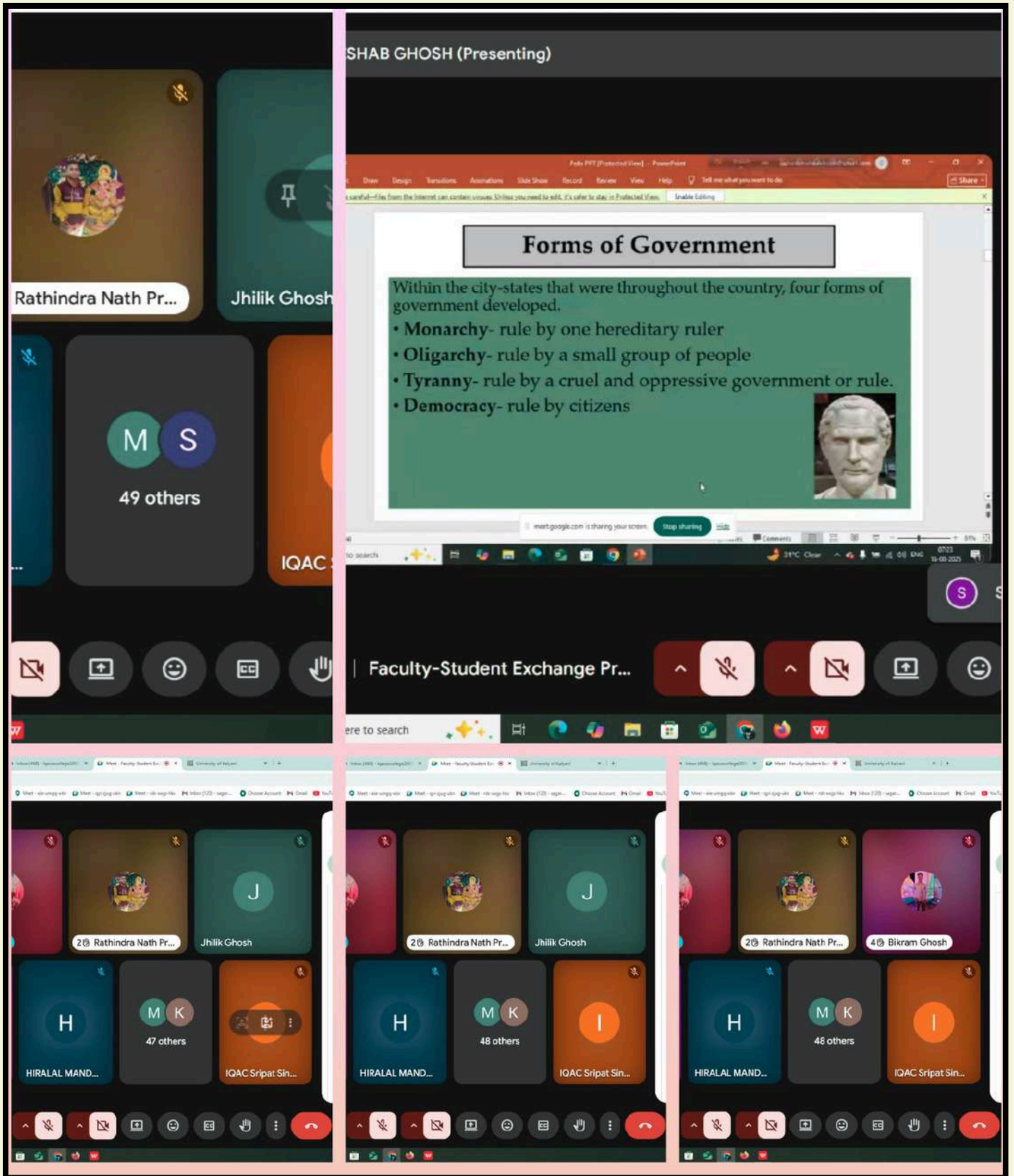

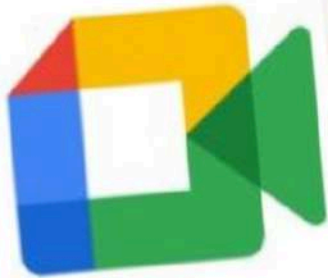
