# Executive Summary

Sripat Singh College, Jiaganj, Murshidabad, in collaboration with the Ramakrishna Mission Swami Vivekananda's Ancestral House and Cultural Centre, Kolkata, successfully conducted the second batch of its Value-Added Course, "Towards Self Realization" (আত্ম-উপলব্ধির পথে), from 8 April to 6 August 2026. Organized under the aegis of the Heritage Club, Department of History, and IQAC, the course was designed to instill ethical, civic, and personal-development values in students beyond the conventional curriculum, through twenty-four structured evening sessions held on Thursdays and Saturdays.

The programme enrolled 144 candidates and covered a broad thematic span—ranging from character building, civility, and social values to financial literacy, time management, enlightened citizenship, and the Indian Knowledge System—delivered by a diverse panel of academicians, spiritual leaders, and subject experts. Assessment combined test performance (120 marks) with attendance (100 marks), and certificates were issued to the 64 students who met the 75% attendance requirement, with Aleya Khatun securing the top aggregate score of 204/220.

# Executive Summary

Attendance analysis across 23 sessions showed considerable variability, with participation ranging from 4 to 57 students per session and an average of approximately 38. Only one student attended all sessions, while the majority of participants (62%) attended fewer than ten sessions, highlighting attendance retention as an area for improvement in future batches. A "Best Student of Every Class" recognition scheme helped sustain engagement among regular attendees throughout the course.

The programme concluded with a Valedictory Session on 1 September 2026, featuring a keynote address by Swami Vedatitanandaji, remarks from institutional leadership, student feedback, cultural performances, and certificate distribution. Overall, the course successfully achieved its objective of broadening students' exposure to value-based education, while attendance data offers useful direction for strengthening future engagement and retention strategies.

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## Background of the Course

Sripat Singh College, an institution rooted in the founding motto of "Peace, Progress, Prosperity," has consistently emphasized the integration of value-based education alongside formal academic instruction as part of its broader institutional mission. Recognizing that holistic student development extends beyond disciplinary knowledge to encompass character, ethics, civic responsibility, and self-awareness, the Heritage Club, Department of History, and the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the College conceived and organized a dedicated Value-Added Course titled "Towards Self Realization" (আত্ম-উপলব্ধির পথে).

To strengthen the philosophical and pedagogical depth of the programme, the College partnered with the Ramakrishna Mission Swami Vivekananda's Ancestral House and Cultural Centre, Kolkata—an institution renowned for its work in value education rooted in the teachings of Swami Vivekananda. This collaboration brought spiritual leaders, academicians, and subject experts together to design a curriculum addressing themes central to personal and social development.

Following the successful conduct of an earlier batch, the second batch of the course was launched on 8 April 2026, with the inaugural session presided over by Swami Jnanalokanandaji, Dr. Kamal Krishna Sarkar (Principal), and Braja Kishor Ghosh (Coordinator, Value Education Programme), reaffirming the institution's commitment to nurturing well-rounded, self-aware, and socially responsible individuals.

## Objectives of the Course

The Value-Added Course "Towards Self Realization" was designed with the following core objectives:

- To introduce students to the philosophical and practical dimensions of self-realization, character building, and human values, complementing their formal academic curriculum.
- To foster an understanding of the distinction between human and animalistic tendencies, encouraging students to cultivate qualities of empathy, discipline, and ethical conduct.
- To promote civic consciousness and enlightened citizenship, equipping students to engage meaningfully with society and their surroundings.
- To acquaint students with elements of the Indian Knowledge System, cultural heritage, and Swami Vivekananda's thoughts on education, fostering a sense of rootedness and identity.
- To build essential life skills, including time management, financial literacy, goal-setting, career planning, and effective communication.
- To encourage harmony, unity, and cooperative living, both within the student community and in broader social contexts.
- To provide a platform for self-reflection and feedback, allowing students to internalize and articulate their personal growth through the course.
- To recognize and reward consistent engagement and excellence through structured evaluation and the "Best Student" recognition scheme, thereby motivating sustained participation.

# Course Design & Structure

The Value-Added Course "Towards Self Realization" was structured as a semester-long, twenty-four-session programme spanning 8 April 2026 to 6 August 2026, delivered in a hybrid pattern combining a physical inauguration with subsequent sessions on Thursdays and Saturdays between 7:00 PM and 8:30 PM—timings deliberately chosen to accommodate students' regular academic schedules.

The curriculum was thematically sequenced to progress from foundational to advanced concepts. Early sessions established conceptual groundwork through topics such as "Value Education – What & Why," "Qualities of Good Students," and "Man vs. Animal: Required Human Qualities." Subsequent sessions built upon this foundation with themes addressing character development, social and cultural values, and the meaning of a successful life. The latter half of the course introduced practical life-skills modules—covering financial knowledge, discipline and time management, career planning, and unity among neighbours—before culminating in reflective sessions on excellence and self-development.

Each session was assigned to a specific resource person with relevant subject expertise, ensuring thematic depth and pedagogical variety. Resource persons included academicians from the College, subject specialists, and monastic representatives from the Ramakrishna Mission, lending both academic rigour and spiritual authenticity to the delivery.

The programme incorporated a built-in evaluation structure, comprising a final written test and a "Best Student of Every Class" recognition mechanism to sustain engagement throughout the course. It concluded with a formal Valedictory Programme featuring structured elements—cultural performances, keynote addresses, student feedback presentations, and certificate distribution—providing a comprehensive closure to the twenty-four-session academic and value-education journey.

## Relevance to Indian Heritage and Culture

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The Value-Added Course "Towards Self Realization" was deeply anchored in India's civilizational ethos, drawing extensively upon the philosophical traditions of Vedanta, the teachings of Swami Vivekananda, and the broader Indian Knowledge System. The collaboration with the Ramakrishna Mission Swami Vivekananda's Ancestral House and Cultural Centre, Kolkata, ensured that the course content remained rooted in indigenous spiritual and ethical frameworks rather than borrowed pedagogical models, situating self-realization within the continuum of India's ancient wisdom traditions.

Sessions such as "Swamiji's Thoughts on Education and its Relevance Today," "Indian Knowledge System," and "Prayers and Concentration" directly engaged students with classical Indian approaches to learning, self-discipline, and inner cultivation. The recitation of Vedic Mantras and Vande Mataram at the valedictory function further reinforced this cultural continuity, connecting contemporary student life with India's spiritual and nationalist heritage. The keynote address by Swami Vedatitanandaji of Ramakrishna Mission, Shilpamandira, Belur Math, embodied the living transmission of monastic wisdom to the student community, reflecting the Ramakrishna-Vivekananda tradition's emphasis on practical Vedanta and character formation.

Themes of humanity, unity among neighbours, social and familial values, and harmony amidst chaos echoed core Indian cultural precepts of collective responsibility and social cohesion. By grounding modern concerns—career planning, financial literacy, time management—within a framework informed by Indian philosophical thought, the course offered students a culturally rooted approach to contemporary challenges. In doing so, it aligned with the National Education Policy's emphasis on integrating Indian heritage and values into higher education, reinforcing cultural identity alongside holistic personal development.

# Course Summary: Value-Added Course on Towards Self Realization (08-04-2026 to 06-08-2026)

The Value-Added Course "Towards Self Realization" was jointly organized by the Heritage Club, Department of History, and IQAC of Sripat Singh College in collaboration with the Ramakrishna Mission Swami Vivekananda's Ancestral House and Cultural Centre, Kolkata. Conducted over four months from 8 April to 6 August 2026, the course comprised twenty-four evening sessions held on Thursdays and Saturdays, inaugurated physically on 8 April 2026 by Swami Jnanalokanandaji, Dr. Kamal Krishna Sarkar, and Braja Kishor Ghosh.

The curriculum spanned a wide array of themes—value education, character building, civility, social and financial literacy, enlightened citizenship, the Indian Knowledge System, discipline, and self-development—delivered by a diverse panel of resource persons drawn from academia, monastic institutions, and professional backgrounds. A total of 144 students enrolled, of whom 64 secured certification by meeting the required 75% attendance threshold, with Aleya Khatun emerging as the top scorer (204/220).

Attendance across the 23 recorded sessions averaged 38 students per date, ranging between 4 and 57, with only one student achieving full attendance. A "Best Student of Every Class" recognition scheme was implemented to encourage sustained engagement, repeatedly honouring students such as Aleya Khatun, Rizia Sultana, and Mithu Saha.

The course concluded with a Valedictory Programme on 1 September 2026, featuring a keynote address by Swami Vedatitanandaji, student feedback, cultural performances, and certificate distribution—marking a successful culmination of the institution's ongoing commitment to values-based education alongside conventional academic learning.

# Assessment Criteria & Methodology

The evaluation framework for the Value-Added Course "Towards Self Realization" was designed to assess students on two complementary dimensions: academic engagement and regularity of participation, ensuring that certification reflected both learning outcomes and sustained commitment to the programme.

## Components of Assessment

**Coursework/Test Marks (out of 120):** Students were evaluated through a written test conducted near the conclusion of the course, assessing comprehension of the values, concepts, and themes covered across the twenty-four sessions.

**Attendance Marks (out of 100):** Attendance was recorded across sessions and converted into a weighted score, incentivizing consistent participation throughout the four-month duration.

**Aggregate Score (out of 220):** The final score was computed as the sum of test marks and attendance marks, providing a composite measure of each student's overall engagement with the course.

## Certification Criteria

In accordance with institutional guidelines, certificates were issued only to students who achieved a minimum of 75% attendance across the course duration. This threshold ensured that certification was reserved for students demonstrating genuine and sustained engagement, rather than assessment performance alone.

## Methodology of Attendance Tracking

Attendance was recorded session-wise across 23 documented dates, with students identified through a combination of registered email, roll number, and name-mobile cross-verification to avoid duplication. This enabled granular classification of students into attendance bands—Very Regular ( $\geq 18$  days), Regular (15–17 days), Moderate (10–14 days), and Irregular ( $< 10$  days)—supporting both certification decisions and administrative analysis of engagement patterns.

## Outcome

Of 144 enrolled candidates, 64 students (approximately 44%) met the attendance criterion and were awarded certificates, with rankings determined by aggregate score. This dual-criterion methodology ensured that the assessment process upheld both academic rigour and the course's underlying emphasis on disciplined, consistent participation.

# Student Feedback Report

As part of the Valedictory Programme held on 1 September 2026, a dedicated segment was allocated for students to share their feedback and reflections on the course, allotted 25–30 minutes with five to seven students presenting for three to five minutes each. This feedback component was designed to allow participants to articulate their personal takeaways from the twenty-four-session programme in their own words, before an audience comprising faculty, invited dignitaries, and monastic representatives from the Ramakrishna Mission.

The inclusion of structured student feedback within the formal valedictory schedule underscores the course's participatory design, treating students not merely as recipients of value education but as active contributors to the programme's assessment and closure. This segment, positioned prominently between the keynote address and remarks from institutional coordinators, reflects the organizers' intent to centre student voice in evaluating the course's impact, complementing the quantitative assessment (test scores and attendance) with qualitative, first-person reflections on personal growth and self-realization achieved through the programme.

# Course Outcome: Knowledge Base

The Value-Added Course "Towards Self Realization" enabled participating students to develop a substantive knowledge base across several interconnected domains of value education and personal development.

**Philosophical and Spiritual Understanding:** Students gained grounding in Vedantic thought and the teachings of Swami Vivekananda, including the distinction between human and animalistic tendencies, the nature of self-realization, and the role of prayer and concentration in personal growth.

**Indian Knowledge Systems and Heritage:** Exposure to sessions on the Indian Knowledge System and Swamiji's educational philosophy equipped students with an understanding of indigenous frameworks of learning, ethics, and cultural identity, distinct from purely Western pedagogical models.

**Civic and Social Awareness:** Students acquired knowledge of enlightened citizenship, social and familial values, civility, and harmonious coexistence, strengthening their capacity to engage constructively within family, campus, and community settings.

**Practical Life Skills:** The course imparted functional knowledge in financial literacy, time management, goal-setting, and career planning—areas often absent from conventional academic curricula but essential for real-world preparedness.

**Character and Personal Development:** Sessions on character building, self-development, and qualities of good students provided students with conceptual tools for ethical decision-making and personal accountability.

Collectively, this knowledge base reflects the course's success in bridging traditional value systems with contemporary applied skills, equipping students—particularly the 64 certified candidates—with a well-rounded foundation for both personal growth and civic engagement.

# Course Outcome: Skill Base

Beyond conceptual knowledge, the Value-Added Course "Towards Self Realization" was designed to cultivate practical, transferable skills among participating students, equipping them for both personal and professional life.

**Self-Management Skills:** Sessions on discipline and time management, prayers and concentration, and self-development helped students build capacities for focus, self-regulation, and sustained personal discipline applicable to academic and everyday life.

**Financial and Career Planning Skills:** Dedicated modules on basic financial knowledge and management, along with goal-setting and career planning, provided students with practical competencies for financial decision-making and structured life/career planning—skills rarely embedded within conventional degree curricula.

**Interpersonal and Social Skills:** Topics such as civility, politeness, and etiquette, social and familial values, and unity among neighbours strengthened students' interpersonal communication, empathy, and conflict-resolution abilities within family, campus, and community contexts.

**Communication and Articulation Skills:** The structured student feedback segment at the valedictory function required participants to publicly reflect on and articulate their learning experiences, building presentation confidence and reflective communication skills.

**Leadership and Civic Engagement Skills:** Sessions on enlightened citizenship and harmony amidst chaos encouraged students to develop civic responsibility and conflict-navigation capacities relevant to collective and community settings.

**Consistency and Commitment:** The attendance-linked certification structure itself reinforced the skill of sustained commitment, as reflected in the 64 certified students who maintained the required 75% attendance across the four-month duration.

Collectively, these skill outcomes complement the course's knowledge base, translating value-education themes into practically applicable competencies for students' personal, academic, and future professional lives.

# Course Outcome: Impact on Students' Perspective

The Value-Added Course "Towards Self Realization" appears to have influenced students' outlook in several discernible ways, as reflected in the course design, participation patterns, and structured feedback mechanisms embedded within the programme.

**Shift Towards Self-Reflection:** By engaging students with themes such as self-realization, self-development, and the human-versus-animal distinction in qualities, the course encouraged participants to move beyond rote academic learning towards introspective evaluation of their own conduct, choices, and aspirations.

**Broadened Understanding of Success:** Sessions addressing "What is a 'Successful Life'" and "Journey Towards Excellence" appear to have prompted students to reconsider conventional, achievement-centric notions of success in favour of a more holistic framework encompassing character, values, and purpose.

**Strengthened Cultural and Civic Identity:** Exposure to the Indian Knowledge System and Vivekananda's philosophy likely reinforced students' sense of cultural rootedness, positioning personal growth within a heritage-informed rather than purely modern secular framework.

**Enhanced Sense of Social Responsibility:** Themes of civility, humanity, unity, and harmony amidst chaos appear designed to shift students' perspective from individual-centric concerns towards greater awareness of their role within family, campus, and community structures.

**Sustained Engagement Among Core Participants:** The emergence of repeat "Best Student" recognitions for the same set of students (e.g., Aleya Khatun, Rizia Sultana, Mithu Saha) suggests that consistent engagement with the course content may have reinforced a deepening, rather than superficial, shift in perspective among the most regular participants.

While the qualitative depth of this perspective shift is best evidenced through the students' own valedictory feedback presentations, the structural and thematic design of the course strongly suggests an intended and plausible transformation in how participating students relate to themselves, their values, and their communities.

# Implementation Challenges

Despite the overall success of the Value-Added Course "Towards Self Realization," implementation of the programme revealed several administrative and operational challenges that merit attention for future batches.

**Attendance Attrition:** The most significant challenge was the steep decline in sustained participation. While 144 students initially enrolled, only 111 unique students engaged with the course at any point, and merely one student attended all 23 recorded sessions. The majority (62.39%) attended fewer than ten sessions, indicating substantial drop-off over the four-month duration and highlighting difficulties in maintaining consistent engagement in a non-mandatory, evening co-curricular format.

**Scheduling Constraints:** Sessions were held on Thursdays and Saturdays between 7:00 PM and 8:30 PM—timings that, while designed to avoid clashing with regular academic hours, may have competed with students' personal commitments, tuition schedules, hostel curfews, or transportation constraints, particularly for outstation and women students.

**Data and Record-Keeping Inconsistencies:** The attendance and result records reveal recurring discrepancies in roll number formatting, duplicate or near-duplicate student entries (e.g., variant spellings of names, inconsistent roll number prefixes), and instances of missing or malformed roll numbers. Such inconsistencies complicated unique student identification and necessitated cross-verification through multiple fields (email, roll number, name-mobile), pointing to a need for more standardized data collection protocols.

**Certification Shortfall:** Only 64 of 144 enrolled students (approximately 44%) met the 75% attendance threshold required for certification, meaning the majority of enrolled candidates, despite initial interest, did not complete the programme's requirements—suggesting a gap between enrolment and course completion.

**Coordination Across Institutions:** As a collaborative programme involving external resource persons from the Ramakrishna Mission and other institutions, coordinating schedules, venues, and resource-person availability across a twenty-four-session, four-month calendar likely required sustained administrative effort and contingency planning.

Addressing these challenges through revised scheduling, strengthened attendance-incentive mechanisms, and improved digital record-keeping would enhance retention and data integrity in subsequent editions of the course.

# Suggestions for Future Batches

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Based on the implementation experience of the Value-Added Course "Towards Self Realization," the following recommendations are proposed to strengthen future batches:

- Improving Attendance Retention
- Introduce mid-course engagement checkpoints (e.g., brief quizzes, group discussions, or reflective assignments) beyond the single terminal test, to sustain student interest throughout the four-month duration.
- Consider flexible session timings or alternate batches (morning/afternoon options) to accommodate students with conflicting evening commitments, tuition schedules, or transportation constraints.
- Explore incentive mechanisms beyond certification alone, such as credit recognition, co-curricular points, or linkage to internship/placement profiles, to strengthen motivation for consistent participation.
- Strengthening Data Management
- Standardize student registration through a single digital form capturing verified roll numbers, department codes, email, and mobile numbers at the point of enrolment, reducing downstream duplication and identification errors.
- Maintain a centralized digital attendance system (e.g., QR-code or biometric-based) to minimize manual recording discrepancies observed in the current attendance records.
- Enhancing Curriculum Delivery
- Consider distributing the twenty-four sessions more evenly across the semester calendar, avoiding long gaps or clustering, to help students maintain continuity of engagement with sequential themes.
- Incorporate more interactive and experiential formats (workshops, case studies, peer discussions) alongside lecture-based sessions to deepen engagement, particularly for practical modules such as financial literacy and career planning.
- Broadening Recognition Mechanisms
- Expand the "Best Student of Every Class" scheme to recognize improvement and consistency, not solely single-session performance, to encourage sustained participation among moderate and irregular attendees.
- Introduce category-wise recognition (e.g., most improved attendance, best feedback presentation) to widen the scope of student motivation.
- Institutional Coordination
- Formalize a shared academic calendar with the Ramakrishna Mission and other collaborating institutions well in advance, to streamline resource-person scheduling and minimize last-minute adjustments.
- Establish a feedback loop involving both certified and non-certified students to better understand barriers to attendance and completion, informing more targeted retention strategies for subsequent batches.

# Reflection on Cultural Awareness

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The Value-Added Course "Towards Self Realization" served as a meaningful platform for deepening students' cultural awareness, situating personal development within the broader continuum of Indian civilizational thought rather than treating it as an abstract or imported concept.

Through sustained engagement with sessions such as "Swamiji's Thoughts on Education and its Relevance Today" and "Indian Knowledge System," students were exposed to indigenous frameworks of learning and self-cultivation that predate and diverge from conventional Western educational paradigms. This exposure encouraged participants to view concepts such as discipline, self-realization, and moral character not as novel constructs but as continuities of a long-standing Indian intellectual and spiritual tradition rooted in Vedantic philosophy and the teachings of Swami Vivekananda.

The collaboration with the Ramakrishna Mission Swami Vivekananda's Ancestral House and Cultural Centre further reinforced this cultural grounding, offering students direct interaction with monastic scholars who serve as living custodians of this heritage. The recitation of Vedic Mantras and Vande Mataram during the valedictory function, alongside the keynote address by Swami Vedatitanandaji, symbolically reaffirmed the course's cultural anchoring, connecting classroom learning with lived ritual and national consciousness.

Sessions on social and familial values, unity among neighbours, and harmony amidst chaos also cultivated an appreciation for community-oriented values distinctive to Indian social philosophy, in contrast to more individualistic conceptions of success and achievement often emphasized elsewhere. By pairing these traditional frameworks with contemporary applications—financial literacy, career planning, enlightened citizenship—the course modeled how heritage-rooted values remain relevant to present-day challenges rather than confined to historical or ceremonial contexts.

Overall, the course appears to have fostered among participating students a renewed sense of cultural rootedness, encouraging them to draw upon indigenous philosophical resources as they navigate questions of identity, purpose, and self-realization in a rapidly modernizing environment.

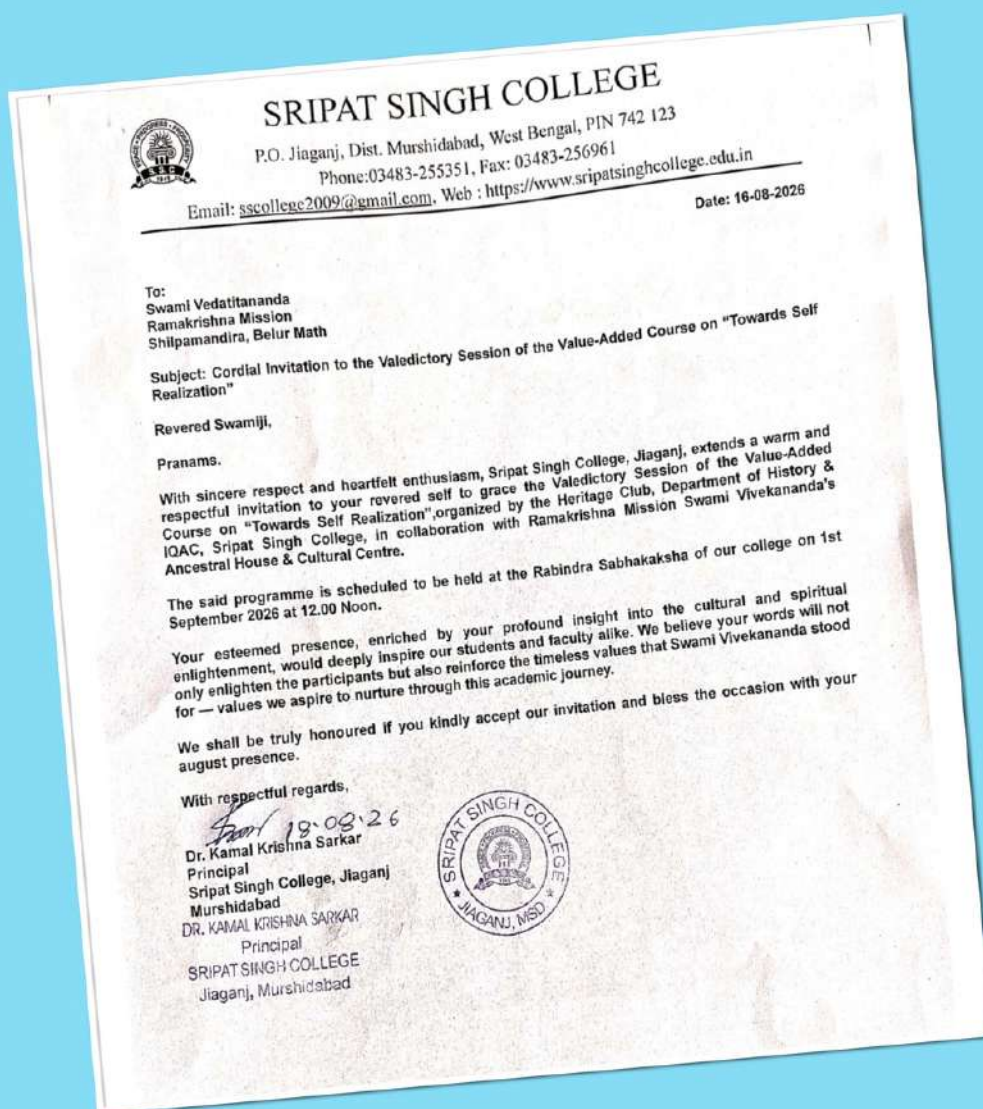

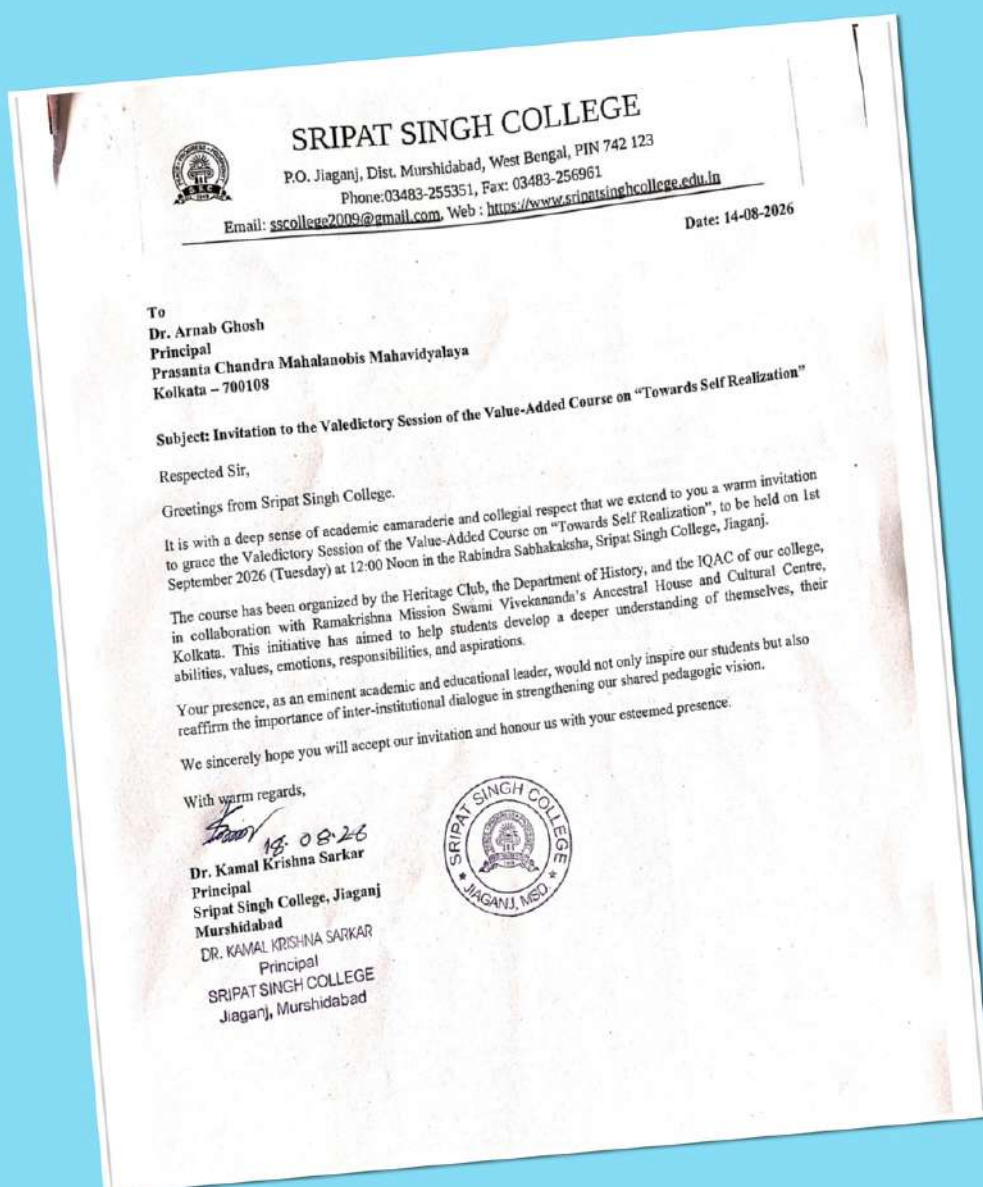
