3.4.1. Summery of the Extension activities in the neighborhood community in terms of impact and sensitizing the students to social issues for their holistic development during the last five years and outcomes of these activities.

Response:

Extension Activities of Sripat Singh College

Sripat Singh College organizes several extensions and social outreach programmes in the local community of Jiaganj-Azimganj Municipality and its nearby rural areas to promote social awareness among the students for their holistic development.

1. Institutional Social Responsibility: Initiative for Covid-19 Awareness

Everybody witnessed the outspread of Covid-19 and its impact on humanity. At that time Sripat Singh College with the help of NSS Unit and Local Administration participated in awareness programme and arranged "Safe Home" facility for the local people of college surroundings. Every teaching and non-teaching staff donated for the preparation of Safe Home in college area. The NSS Unit of Sripat Singh College, at that time spread its hands towards the people of Jiaganj, the area sorroundings our college and distributed protective musk and made people aware about the Do's and Don'ts and the college authority with the collaboration of NSS Unit and Dhrity Foundation, made arrangements of "SAFE HOME" and bought some equipment for Covid affected people. This "Safe Home" was consisted of 20 beds along with a medical team provided by the Jiaganj Gramin Hospital.











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2. Institutional Social Responsibility: Free Classes for the Children at Adopted Village

This is an Educational Outreach programme which was designed for the Children studying in primary schools. The NSS Volunteers of Sripat Singh College spent a day with the little children of the adopted village. The main objective of this initiative to provide an enjoyable and pleasant classroom learning atmosphere through a playful teaching-learning process.









- **3.** Regular and Special Camping Programmes: During the session of last five years NSS Unit of Sripat Singh College performed many co-curricular activities and social awareness activities. Details of the programmes are given below.
- 3.1.NSS Unit of Sripat Singh College Organized a **Workshop on Blood Related Diseases** in February, 2022. The main objective of the programme was to make awareness among the students about the diseases transmitted through blood. At the same time, an interactive session was arranged for the discussion with the teachers and students. All the faculty members and students were participated in the programme.

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3.2. Ground Water Quality Test and Water Related Diseases Awareness

The students tested the PH level of water and made awareness among the villagers.

gave service to the people lived in the slum area. A socio-economic survey was done in slum area on the basis of a structured questionnaire. The main objective of the camp was to observe the socio-economic conditions of the people.





At the same time the volunteers gave their labor to clean the college campus and hostel ground.



3.9 Special Camping Programme:

As per manual of NSS every unit, organization of a Special Camp in every financial year is a mandatory routine. NSS Unit of Sripat Singh College organized a Special Camp in the financial year of 2023 from

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3.10 World No Tobacco Day:

NSS Unit with the collaboration of District Tobacco Control Cell (Murshidabad) organized a seminar on the side- effects of tobacco on youth generation. On that occasion, CMOH of Murshidabad District was our chief guest. He delivered a lecture on the topic and explained the side-effects of tobacco. Prof. Asis Kumar Sen (TIC) of Sripat Singh College was present there. All the teaching and non-teaching staff were there. Almost 60 volunteers participated in the programme.









The main objective of this program was to make awareness among the youth especially college goer students who generally get addicted during their student life. A team of doctors from Murshidabad Medical College was present at the programme. They shared their experience met with the patients badly suffering from tobacco related disesses.



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Outcome of the overall activities performed by the NSS Unit of Sripat Singh College

Sripat Singh College is situated beside the river bank of Gange river under Jiaganj- Azimganj Municipality in Murshidabad district. This is one of the oldest educational institutes in the city. The college was established in 1949. Naturally, it has a great impact on the people and the students living at college surroundings.

- 1. Jiaganj is a semi-town and a large section of people live in village. Most of the students come from a middle class or backward society, even a large section of students are first generation learners. And that's why different activities whether it is health related, or related to social issues, performed by the NSS Unit, has a great impact upon the students as well as on the local people of the area.
- 2. One of the major issues is the high level of Arsenic found in water of College surrounding area. NSS Unit of Sripat Singh College took initiative to make people aware about the drinking of impure water. Many seminars and workshops are being arranged on a regular basis for the awareness of the students.
- 3. One of the social problems is that almost 1/3rd of the college female students got married at under age or before completion of their 18th birthday. In this respect, social activity of NSS Unit improve the situation better than before. Many seminars and awareness programme specially arrange only for female students to make them aware of their problems related to adolescent period.
- 4. NSS Unit of Sripat Singh College play a very vital role in creating awareness related to environment issues. Every year many initiatives take to plant trees in different parts of the college campus as well as college surroundings. At the same time, many seminars on various environment issues organizes to make the students aware.
