

1st Speaker : Dr. Pijush Poddar

Dr. Poddar stated his views about the origin of poetry, views of towards love, nature, romanticism, death and others points and how his poems become unique among the poets of 50's. His lecture became so attractive that all the students were eager to go through the poems of Sakti Chattopadhyay.



2nd Speaker : Sumit Banerjee

Prof. Sumit Banerjee, ex prof. of our department illustrated how the emotions towards of birth and death in Shakti's poem. He starts from his poem ' Jarasandha' to 'Jete pari kintu keno jabo' and tried to show that how feelings of life and death engulfed the poet and how poet shakti made his personal feelings to universal in his poem. In the lecture of fifty minutes prof banejee gave a brief idea about the poet and almost all the audience became interested about the great poet.
