

A Seminar for celebrating the 185th birth anniversary of the famous writer and novelist Sri Bankimchandra Chattopadhyay was held in Bengali Department, Jagatpat Singh Kalamandir, on 26th June, 2023 at 12.00 noon. 1st lecture:
